


SilverStream

The Silver stream lineup is a middle game series with seabass being the core target, yet possessing the qualities to deal with situations targeting flounders and Akame (Japanese red-eye barramundi). All models exhibit the power to target the lunker seabass and have been arranged depending on blank characteristics.

3 highly sensitive models in the "Flows" series that are designed to decipher the intricate currents, 1 model in the "Tradition" series that is equipped with the tenacity and torque, and 2 models in the "Red-Eye" series for those anglers targeting monstrous seabass and Akame. These seabass rods are not specialized for situations or concepts but will exhibit its true potential dependent on the anglers' skill.



SilverStream 96 Tradition

Tradition 96 is a model with flexibility, high elasticity and lightness blended into this single blank with added controllability to go head to head with monstrous seabass. Unlike those heavy models which simply tend to be way too stiff, this rod will create a parabolic bend curve even when smaller fish are on, yet having extreme torque once more load is on the blank. $Although \ it \ has \ a \ parabolic \ bending \ ability, \ we \ have \ managed \ to \ maintain \ the \ Ripple \ Fisher$ spirit in the blank with sharpness when casting. This bend enables anglers to parry the sudden torquful dash from the fish, while efficiently and easily surfacing the lunker size seabass. This Tradition 96 is a rod for anglers who definitely wants to land the monstrous fish. (The blank has not been renewed from the old naming "Monster Impact Tradition 96")

SilverStream 810 Flows Nano

The Flows 810 is the core model of the series with its ideal length for seabass fishing equipped with a strong butt power. It is especially outstanding with its casting swing through and high sensitivity. Anglers will be able to decipher the subtle difference in current movements while maintaining the high response required for an efficient and effective hookup. It may seem a little too stiff when anglers initially take a hold, but once you are out in the field casting, retrieving and fighting the fish, it will bend nicely. With its high tolerance, the butt will still hold extra power even when fighting a monstrous seabass. It is an ideal rod for use in various locations from estuaries, straits, rocks and even surf casting with the use of minnows, vibrations, sinking pencils and top water lures.

SilverStream 96 Flows Nano

The Flows 96 is designed for use in large river systems, estuaries, surf casting and wading in the flats which require long distance casting of large lures. The balance of the rod is outstanding and anglers will not notices its 96 length. It also possesses a highly sensitive blank to feel for the slight change in currents. The 810 is a type of rod to conquer the current, where as the 96 is designed more to feel for the changes in current far away. The lightish tip section will allow anglers to not only utilize large lures but also various smaller minnows and vibration type lures. The concept for the Flows 96 is "distance" and "sensitivity".

SilverStream 103 Flows Nano

The Flows 103 is a model designed for use off the rocks and surf casting which require the power and sharpness to cut through the strong head winds. It allows anglers to easily cast and $% \left(1\right) =\left(1\right) \left(1\right)$ trace smaller lures which weren't possible with the stronger black-fin models, while also having the power required to swing through with heavier lures. Even with its long length, the blank made up with the new NANOALLOY® technology has enabled the rod to maintain its sharpness. The unique characteristic of the Nano blank also exerts the underlying power once the rod is loaded with a lunker size fish off rough rocks and heavy seas.

The 87 Red-Eye is a power rod we present to anglers targeting the monstrous seabass and the infamous Akame (Japanese red-eye barramundi) inhabiting the Shimanto River. It is not simply an over powered rod, but possesses a flexible tip enabling anglers to cast and control small to large minnows. The blank is tolerant and will lift the fish with its repulsive $\underline{\text{force while}}$ having great casting capabilities of large lures with the least amount of effort. Furthermore, the 87 is designed with a short length grip for easier usage in the wading game. It is a user-friendly rod with the combined features of sensitivity and power, dedicated for those

SilverStream 97 RED EYE Nano

In contrast to the $87\ \text{Red}$ Eye, we have increased its power, ability to load the rod and castability. Although its concepts are the same as the 87, with the combined attributes of sensitivity and power, this model is most suited for a more extensive field. It's ideal to rip out massive Red-eyes, but also seabass off the rocks, black-fin seabass nearing the estuaries, and lunker size seabass lurking around the tetrapod's. The response and high sensitivity required to instantaneously pull away the monstrous fish off the structures have been finely honed through the use of Nano material in the blank. This was our answer to stand at the pinnacle of rod making. We are proud to produce the next generation of power rods, the "Red-eye" series.

 $The \ Black-fin\ seabass\ game\ is\ conducted\ under\ harsh\ environmental\ conditions\ with$ strong head winds, heavy swells, complicated currents and uneven footing. The anglers have little advantage in these unforgiving conditions and the only way to overcome these factors are experience and the ability to analyze and make an efficient/good judgment in a given situation.

We have added the sharpness by employing the new Nano blank while fine tuning the standard capabilities as a black-fin seabass rod.

Anglers will cut through the strong head winds and sew through the complicated currents. The highly sensitive blank will allow anglers to notice the subtle changes in current and flow to inform you of bite spots.

Avarice 103M Nano

The long awaited short length M class model is ready! This 103 length is light, easy to handle and is efficient when fishing from low rock formations or bolder rocks for the black-fin seabass or the normal seabass off the rocks and fishing from the surf for flounders. Although it is short in length, the blank will bend nicely to withhold the fish. This is a new generation of Black-fin seabass rod with the combined properties of long casting, butt power and the newly added element of light/easy handling.

Avarice 106MH Nano

It possesses a stronger butt section compared to the 103M and with its refined taper design, it maintains the easy handling of the rod while improving its castability. The bigger the fish on the other end of the line, the more power it will exert, constantly applying pressure on the fish to efficiently surface it. You will be able to first handedly experience how the carbon material has evolved from this 10ft 6inch blank packed with castability, loading power and controllability of the fish.

This is an almighty rod with its ideal length and power settings for use anywhere, anytime. It is capable of cutting through strong head winds, while having the ability to cast small lures to pinpoint accuracy and not to mention its overwhelming butt power. The Nano blank characteristics can be noticed in the contradicting nature of its sharpness when casting and its ability to bend nicely once it is loaded.

Monsterimpact

The Monster Impact series are the most powerful of our lineup for seabass to go head to head with those monstrous black-fin seabass. These are not rods for everyone. They have been designed and made with the premise that the angler is not in a favorable position on the rocks. In other words, unfavorable conditions are the norm and the blanks have been designed to overcome the monstrous fish under these conditions.

It isn't rear for Blue runners to also come about when targeting these super size Black-fin. It is reassuring when using the Monster Impact for areas with both the blue runners and Black-fins swimming about. Although anglers will be able to cast out your usual Black-fin minnows, they also possesses an overwhelming power compared to your ordinary Black-fin rods, so we only recommend these rods for those anglers who are well experience and know what they want.

For those lunker anglers who know where the Black-fin bite and where the monstrous ones are hiding, these rods will surely become you next best friend.

MonsterImpact 101HH Nano / Spinnnig Model

Like the 110HH, this rod is also designed to target both the black-fin and blue runners but this 101HH is set more towards the blue-runners. In other words, it is for anglers who are targeting blue-runners and might want to also cast out a few small lures for the black-fin. The short length 10ft 1inch and its short grip has been set for use around flat rock formations, to increase the casting accuracy and balance. Although it is a rod for the black-fin, it can also be used for situations where the bait-fish are extremely small when targeting the blue-runners with smaller lures.

Monster | mpact 110HH / Spinnnig Model

This model has been designed with the power to overcome both the blue-runners and the black-fin seabass. It is not simply a harder and stiffer rod, but will bend tenaciously with the sudden run of the Kingfish. It is also ideal for fishing in heavy seas and strong head winds to target the monster class black-fin. Although it is a powerful rod, the tip section has been build with some flexibility for anglers to punch out those smaller lures. The belly to butt section of the rod is a HH class and has the strongest power of the lineup.

MonsterImpact 110HH HIRA / Bait Casting Model

This is the highly responsive bait-casting Hirasuzuki (Black-fin seabass) model with great casting capabilities. This HIRA bait-casting model is composed with lightweight grip and guides to improve its balance, casting accuracy, lure and fish controllability, while being delicate and powerful at the same time. We present the holy grail of fishing rods to the hard-core anglers who strive to pursue the bait-casting style for their Hirasuzuki game.

MonsterImpact 110HH BLUE / Bait Casting Model

The 110HH BLUE bait-casting model has been developed with a blank focused on targeting the blue-runners (Kingfish, Yellow-tails and Amberjacks, etc.). It is stronger and stiffe compared to the HIRA bait-casting model, able to load the rod and cast out middle to large size lures. For targets are around 5kg, anglers will be able to lure-out the fish by analyzing the landscape and currents or efficiently cast out to feeding frenzies out in the open. Once the fish is on, the stiff characteristics of the rod will soon transform into a tenacious rod, absorbing the violent power of the blue-runners thrashing along the rocks.

They say, "Persuasion is often more effective than force". It took us a while to produce, but we are finally happy with the product. You will surely be surprised with its lightness and controllability once you take hold of this rod. This rod will put the angler in an advantageous position at the hardest of times when land-based fishing for the blue-runners.

The long awaited lighter plugging model has been produced in the Runner Exceed lineup. With its soft tip section, anglers will be able to utilize lures ranging from 20g minnows, medium size diving pencil and even jigs weighing up to 90g when the bite range is far and deep. It is ideal for anglers targeting Kingfish and Amberjacks to 5kg and Yellow-tail weighing up to 10kg. The Nano blank will allow for a speedy and efficient fight using the repulsive force of the rod.

RunnerExceed 104H Nano PlugModel

This land-based blue-runner rod was built with the purpose of practicality and power. The flexibility was the most important aspect for the development of the rod. While being able to easily control diving pencils through its soft tip, once the rod is loaded with the fish, it will exhibit its true power and potential. Compared to the current 103H, more flexibility is given to the belly section, allowing for anglers to lift the rod higher to withstand the final thrust of the fish in close range.

RunnerExceed 911MH Nano

We refined the 911EMH blank and employed the new NANOALLOY® material for a sharper casting feel and long castability while giving the angler better balance during the fight. It is an ideal rod for targeting $5\sim6kg$ blue-runners from the rocks with the ability to also handle the unexpected 10kg class fish. This versatile rod will allow anglers to utilize both jigs and plugs for any given situation and possesses the power to lift 3-4kg fish out of the water with the rod. With its ability to cast a mile with jigs up to 100g, the ideal length to maneuver the jig with the rod under your armpits and absolute balance and flex so the fish doesn't violently thrash about, this rod will surely be your next right arm.

RunnerExceed 103H

This is a power up model of the 911MH for use with both jigs and plugs targeting blue-runners $\,$ around the 10kg mark. Although the cast feeling is sharp, the 103 length of the rod will load up nicely to apply pressure to the fish. For those anglers who prefer the use of plugs, the sharp casting feel will be ideal for you. Anglers will be able to utilize both poppers and pencil type

RunnerExceed 105BHH Nano / Bait Casting Model



The RunnerExceed 100SHH/Limited is scheduled to be released in the spring of 2018 as a limited edition for production. It is a lightweight, highly repulsive tuned model that absorbs the impact from the fish while swiftly recovering its original form. It is composed of 2 different types of highly repulsive materials for anglers to challenge their limits against monstrous targets.

While the rod possesses the power for land-based GT fishing off the rocks or breakwaters, its lightness and lifting power will support the anglers at the moment most needed. We recommend anglers to try this rod for land-based fishing targeting massive blue-runners and GT where your usual blue-runner rod won't cut it. Ideal to go head to head against monstrous Amberjacks and supersize Kingfish lurking in the shallow areas.

Our goal was to create a rod that possess the power of an XH class rod while having the lightness of a H class blue-runner rod.

The whole rod is stiff including the tip section, able to sharply cast out lures with the strong repulsive force from the blank. Anglers can not only comfortably cast and control large lures weighing 150g, but can also cast out smaller lures weighing 40g by loading the rod with the weight of the lure. With the strong repulsive force, the rod is also ideal for use with jigs. Anglers will easily be able to aggressively fight fish around 10kg with the outstanding lift power and tenacity.

Compared to the Final Standup SXH, this 100SHH/LIMITED is milder on the anglers' body, bending more near the butt section for a more H class feeling of a rod. This is a highly resilient carbon rod not only ideal for anglers targeting monstrous size blue-runners but also great as a entry level land-based GT rod.






RealCrescent Static load comparison of RealCrescent (250g load)



On the left, you can see a comparative diagram of the bend curve of the new Real Crescent series with a static load of 250g. The most basic light game model is the RC-65. The RC-55 is designed for use with a singular body jig-head and the RC-75 is for use with Carolina rigs and metal jigs. The RC-81 seems to be the strongest rod but able to utilize a variety of lures with flexibility of the whole rod. As for the bait-casting models, the RC-57 is designed for use with singular body jig-heads and the RC-67 is ideal for both the jig-head and small lures. The RC-77 is the stiffest model of the series, suited for bottom knocking and dragging techniques to target rockfish and bream game. In the diagram, you may notice that the RC-81 and RC-77 have a similar bending curve and power, however they have a totally different characteristics with the 77 being much stiffer while the 81 being more flexible.




Static load comparison of SilverStream (1kg load)




On the left, you can see a comparative diagram of the bend curve of the seabass and red-eye models in the Silver Stream series with a static load of 1kg. As a reference, we have also presented the 103M Avarice, which has similar characteristics to the 103 Flows. In the Silver Stream series, the Tradition has a somewhat slow taper design with Flows being regularfast taper and the Red-Eye models having a powerful butt section with a regular taper. The handling of the rod is similar to what you can see in the diagram, but its true power and potential will only be seen when more weight is loaded on the rod. It is not simply a stiff rod but designed to produce its true power as more weight is loaded on the rod. The 96 Tradition and 103 Flows have a moderate casting feel while the 810 and 96 Flows will cast out with the help of its sharpness and repulsive force. The tenacious 87 and 97 Red-Eye will cast out best by loading the rod and increasing your head-speed.


On the left, you can see a comparative diagram of the bend curve of the Hirasuzuki (black-fin seabass) models in the Avarice series with a static load of 2kg. The Avarice series have been composed with extra reinforcement in the blank to enable anglers to punch out their lures in strong headwinds and load the rod to fight the fish. The 110H is most noteworthy with power to go head to head with blue-runners around 5kg yet possessing the sensitivity and lightness to utilize minnows. In contrast to the Monster Impact series designed for both the blue-runners and Hirasuzuki, the Avarice series have a more delicate tip section to improve the controllability of lighter minnows most suited for the Hirasuzuki game. The 103M has the most flexible blank for use in flat rock formations, whereas the 106MH and 110H models are designed for the toughest of situations easting from rough rock formations.




**The bending curves presented in the diagram are all set with a reel while loading the blank with a static load. Please note that this diagram does not indicate the repulsive force of the rod. Also, the bending curve of the rod does not fully exhibit the rods characteristics. 
MOISTERINDACT Static load comparison of MonsterImpact (2kg load)




On the left, you can see a comparative diagram of the bend curve of the Monster Impact series designed for both the Hirasuzuki (black-fin seabass) and blue-runners with a static load of 2kg. We have also included the 102M of the RunnerExceed series as a reference. In the Monster Impact series, both the spinning and bait-casting models possess similar power class with each individual model distinguished by stiffness and taper. The stiffest and most tenacious blanks have been used for the 110HH and 110HH bait-casting model HIRA giving it the sharpest feel of the series. With similar power class, the 101HH is designed with a softer tip section and will bend nicely to load the rod while the 110HH bait-casting model (for blue-runners) also designed to load the tenacious blank. All models are equipped with a tip capable of casting and controlling sizable blue-runner lures, and are either distinguished by stiffness and power to stop the fish or tenacity to absorb the thrashing of the blue-runners.

Presented here are the bending curves of the RunnerExceed series with a still weight of 2kg. The 103H and the 104H have similar butt power, yet having very different characteristics. The stiffer 103H is ideal to control jigs and plugs, aggressively stopping the violent fish. In contrast, the more giving 104H is developed to control the more sensitive diving pencils while possessing the repulsive force once loaded, which are distinctive features of the Nano material. The 100SHH LTD is similar in this respect, possessing outstanding repulsive power to lift the fish. Although it seems to be bending more than the 103H in the diagram, it is a more powerful rod. If you prefer a sharper rod to control jigs and poppers, we recommend the 91HM or 103H, whereas the 102M or 104H are more suitable for anglers who predominantly use diving pencils. Please refer to the comparison between the Final Standup series with the 105BHH and 100SHH.



The 103H, 100SXH and 105BXH are equipped with overwhelming power and stiffness while the 104H, 100SHH and 105BHH are composed of the Nano blank that helps anglers endure the thrashing of the fish by loading the rod and utilizing its repulsive force to lift the fish

Strength?.....while all these are important factors, we believe that a true big game rod is when the average angler is able to handle it.

Taking the limits of a human body into account, a fine balance is needed as such with years of experience in this field, we at Ripple Fisher develop rods such to assist the anglers to conserve their energy particularly when the fish is fighting aggressively.

In 2018, BIG TUNA 76 is released for anglers who aim TUNA over 200kg.

OceanRidge **BIG TUNA 85F** JAPAN Special

This 85F will allow anglers to cast out small lures with great distance with the use of lines between PE3~6 and lures ranging from 18g ~ 120g. It is a tenacious and bendy rod so it is less likely for anglers to break the rod when high sticking. Use of general light tuna rods result in a long and grueling fight as angles are worried about rod breakage or line breakages, however, this 85F is not a light tackle rod. It is a new generation of tuna rods which exceed the line and knot breakage specifications. Although it possesses the power to overcome Tuna exceeding 50kg, this tolerant rod will also be ideal for casting for targets such as Yellow-tails and Kingfish in your local waters.

OceanRidge **BIG TUNA 87** JAPAN Special

When targeting a selective fish like the Blue Fin Tuna, a rod must be able to handle various lures ranging from 30gm to 120gm. Furthermore with a monster class fish weighing over 100kg, a line rating of PE#12 is required. This posed contradictory requirements for rod builders like us. If we seek for casting distant, the rod power is sacrificed and if power is increased, lighter lures are unusable. So in order to meet both these requirements of power vs light lures on PE#12 line, we conducted extensive testing for the placement of the guides

OceanRidge **BIG TUNA 85** JAPAN Special

Compared to the BIG TUNA 87, it has a sharper casting feel to it. The lifting power has also increased 10~20% compared to the TUNA 87 (has similar power as the TUNA710). It is a well balanced power model perfect for targeting Tuna exceeding the 50kg mark with the use of 40a~100a lures.

OceanRidge **BIG TUNA 710** JAPAN Special

In contrast to the 87, this rod is sharp when casting while possessing the tenacity and added lifting power. Although it is possible for anglers to high stick this rod to conserve energy, the lifting power will allow anglers to take initiative of the fight before it ends up becoming a long drawn-out battle. You could say that this rod will only show its true evolutionary

lew OceanRidge BIG TUNA 76 JAPAN Special

This model is for anglers with their sights on Bluefin tuna weighing over 200kg. Similar to the $\,$ 73, this 76 is capable of not only casting large lures mostly used when the targets are feeding on dolphin fish (mahi-mahi), but also allows anglers to cast and control the lighter (60g) sinking pencils for smaller baits. The difference from the 73 will be the contrasting fight style. While possessing strong butt power to constantly apply pressure on the fish, we have drastically reduced the load on the angler by bringing the bending point closer to the angler, allowing for a prolonged fight.

OceanRidge **BIG TUNA 73** JAPAN Special

This model is for anglers with their sights on Bluefin tuna weighing over 200kg. Its castability is next to non, able to accurately hit feeding targets with large lures most productive when they are feeding on dolphin fish (Mahi-mahi). Being short in length and the stiffest model (after the discontinued 77International) in the series, it is most suited for anglers who have confidence in their strength and ability to go head to head with the monstrous tuna.

*Recently it has become possible to catch Blue-fin tuna with weight exceeding 200kg. However, there are also dangers involved when targeting tuna exceeding 100kg in rough conditions. Although models such as the BIG TUNA 76 and 73 are designed to target "Blue-fin tuna over 200kg", the specifications have been set and explanations written down with the assumption that the angler has sufficient strength, training and experience in the field.



The length of rear grips of BIG TUNA series are longer than others to be held on lower position. To reduce the physical burden of anglers from long period of fight, we re you to choose gimbal belt which can be equiped on lower position.

The Aquila series are the rods to support your boat casting game for Bonito's, Dorado's to various blue runner species, in addition to the large Kingfish, Yellow-fin Tuna's and Blue-fin Tuna's. The possibilities of the boat game are forever increasing in diversity, allowing anglers to lure out targets to the surface previously never attempted. With the evolving lures/lines on the market and the increasing size of the targets becoming more and more selective, the expectations towards the ability of the rods are also advancing.

The blanks of the Aquila series have been developed with the combining capabilities of lightness, castability and outstanding butt power. Without total balance of your tackle, we believe that it will not be possible to capitalize on the very rare chance of a big hit presented to you in the boat game.

We have categorized and renewed the labeling of the power class of the line-up for easier distinctions between the various models. The four types include the "Basic", "Sensitive", "Extreme" and "Monster".

Aquila 74M / Basic type

This model is for anglers who prefer using light tackle on Yellowtail or Kingfish. With a shorter length, an underarm cast is possible while it efficiently works the lure for that special moment. (Previous name: 783)

Aquila 81M / Basic type

This is the long length model of the Aquila 74M which was designed for casting. It is not only great for large Dorado's and bonito's, but it is also ideal for light tackle Kingfish or yellowtail casting game. During the testing, it landed an 80kg bluefin tuna under 50 minutes, proving its true potential, even though it is a light game rod. (Previous name:813)

Aquila 87MH / Basic type

In the heated tuna game where countless boats are chasing the same pack, this rod was designed to enable anglers to cast super small ~ medium size lures a great distance. It is a model between the Aquila 81M and 82H. The lightness and sharpness is somewhat similar to the Aquila 813. The grip has been extended to handle the long and grueling fight against the Tuna. (Suggested target size : ~50kg) (Previous mame:874)

Aquila 74MH Nano / Sensitive type

This rod is ideal for targeting Kingfish off charter boats which require anglers to under-cast their lures. It is also suited for your usual overhead casting techniques in smaller boats. Although the tip section is slightly more flexible than the previous model, the blank has a more powerful and speedy lift power allowing anglers to maintain the initiative. With the new guide settings, we have managed to reduce any line trouble and increased the casting distance when under-casting. (Previous name:745)

Aquila 82H / Sensitive type

This is another model designed with space constraint in mind. The tip section differs from the rest of the Aquila series, it has a fine tip section and good flexing power enabling an underarm cast. With minimal 'kick back', your lure will be catapulted further with little effort. Handling of the rod feels natural and effortless. The fine tip section also presents more controllability. Using short jerking motion will impart a more natural action. It has all the hallmarks of the Aquila series renowned for its casting qualities while possessing a lighter tip section. The butt section is strong enough to withstand a 10kg fish in shallow waters. (Previous name:825)

Aquila 78MH Nano / Extreme type

The "Aquila 78MH Nano" has the sharpest blank settings of the series. It is ideal for anglers who like a more manual control of their lure. With the same concept as the original model, it has the sharpest casting feel and lure operability while enhancing the response and lifting speed. When the anglers are able to utilize this rod to its true potential, it will be your next best friend. Also casting distance due the guide settings is noteworthy, rivaling those of an 8ft class rod. It is an ideal rod for your local to exotic fishing destinations targeting Yellow-tail, Kingfish and Tuna weighing up to 50kg. (Previous name:785)

Aquila 85H Nano / Extreme type

Tuna/Kingfish rod using extra small lures. We have made the tip section of the "Aquila 81H Nano" slightly more flexible and the load of the fish closer towards the angler. This has reduced the strain on the angler for long grueling fights against Tuna while allowing anglers to utilize a wider array of lures. You will even be able to utilize 30-40g lures and rocket them out to feeding frenzies. 

It is also a great light tackle rod for your GT game. (Previous name:815)

Aquila 85H+ / Monster typ

The Aquila-Monster type is especially designed with the concentrated ability to go head to head with large monstrous Kingfish. However, it is not simply a rod with great power, but also has the lightness and great balance for anglers to cast all day to lure out the targets and ability to respond to sudden runs vertically and horizontally. We were also insistent on where the pivotal point of the bend curve is positioned when the rod is loaded. Anglers will be able to maintain their balance while fighting on the bow of the boat as the load is set closer to the body of the angler. The 85H + is designed for use with 40 ~ 120g lures, casting long distances from the bow of medium to large size charter boats.

Aquila 711HH+ / Monster type

Like the 85H+ Monster, the 711HH+ Monster is also designed to target large size Kingfish. It is a model especially designed for those situations where your target is feeding on large bait-fish like small dorado's, flying-fish etc and need to cast large/heavy lures around 150g. As you are able to cast from around 80g, it is also ideal for medium to small boats or anglers who prefer to challenge themselves with a heavier drag near shallow waters with heavy snags. Similar to the 85H+, the smooth bend curve will transfer the load closer to your body for a more stable fight position.



With the use of the Nano material, it has improved the sensitivity and lift speed while maintaining a tenacious bend.

OceanArrow SELFISH 655S Nano

655S which got more power than 654S have been given faster lifting speed while maintaining a tenacious bend. If you are going to aim kingfish or great amberjack over 10kg, this 655S Nano is recommended. This have been designed for horizontal jerking so the action of the jig will be more toned down and is ideal for anglers to maintain the line tension while maneuvering the jig horizontally. Of course you can jerk jig vertically when you try not to move jig too much. The potential of 655S Nano will be derive depend how you fish with it.



The concept for our renewal was to design a true TaiRubber rod with the lifting power and sensitivity that disregards depth or strength of current. This 67UL is a representation of the unique characteristics of Ripple Fisher's rods with its delicate sensitivity while possessing the butt power able to control the overwhelming strength of the fish.

OceanArrow 65L Snapper

The 65L is a model which is able to conduct a smooth retrieval under heavy pressure against the TaiRubber in deep waters and strong currents. The highly sensitive blank will transmit the slightest changes in current pressure and chases from your target through the blank, giving anglers another element to consider when fishing. The blank itself possesses an ideal stiffness and flexibility to efficiently and effectively hookup the fish. To put it into perspective, if the 67UL is a rod with a sensitive tip with a powerful butt section, this 65L is a rod which exhibits its power and sensitivity through the smooth bend of the whole rod. Although the 65L is mainly developed for TaiRubber fishing, it is also equipped with the ideal settings for light jigging and the Inchiku game.

OceanArrow 66ML Snapper

The 66ML has a grip joint structure with an increased butt power compared to the previous two models. It is not only great for your TaiRubber game but an all-rounder rod for the Inchiku game, jigging and even soft plastics game to target the various species you may encounter when fishing from your boat. With its versatility, anglers can make good use of their light line to suit your own style of fishing to target any given species from your boat over even a kayak where you may be limited with the number of rods you can take. We are positive that this rod will be your next best friend for not only local waters but also fishing expeditions where you may have to deal with large snappers, groupers, hair-tail, blue-runners etc.






BIG TUNA Static load on rods set at different angles



Static load comparison of BIG TUNA 85F & BIG TUNA 87 (6kg load) These two models are ideal for situations where your targets are feeding on small Sardines and require you to cast small lures. A still weight of 6kg is loaded onto the rods designed for use with PE6. Although both models are suitable for PE6, the lifting power of the 87 is more superior to the 85F, capable of targeting larger fish.




These two models are the core of the series capable of use with various size lures for different bait sizes. The 85 is an extended model of the 710. with a sharper tip section compared to the 87 when casting. Although the long length blank may feel stiffer, the butt section of the 710 is



Static load comparison of BIG TUNA 85 & BIG TUNA 710 (10kg load) Static load comparison of BIG TUNA 76 and BIG TUNA 73 (10kg load) These models will assist anglers for situations where large lures are required due to the targets feeding on large baits such as dolphin fish. At a 45° angle, both the 73 and 76 can be seen to have the same power However, once the rod is lifted even higher, the 76 will start bending closer to the body, reducing the load on the angler. The 73 has a sharp casting feel while able to fight the fish speedily.

*The load on the body will feel different for each individual bending the rod. The Static load comparison is simply a reference.




The Aquila 85H+ and 711HH+ do not differ too much regarding the power, but have totally different characteristics when controlling the lure. The 711HH+ is nost suited in seasons where the targets are feeding on sizable baits and require the angler to utilize large lures. We hope you will take into account the field condition, size of your charter boat, fight style, season and size of lure when choosing your rods.






Static load comparison of Ultimo (6kg load)



The Ultimo series are designed for use with diving pencil/diving popper type lures and some models are also great for use with Tuna and Kingfish. Although ML lass have not employed NANOALLOY® technology, it is bent very smoothly to apply good enough pressure on fish continuously. Rest of models are employed NANOALLOY® technology to achieve strong repulsive force to keep applying good amount of pressure with even small amount of input. Differences of potential of each rod make ML is classified as to characteristics while on fighting. Yet ML class have less power to pull fish up to surface than other models, it have enough potential for beginner or even for expert because of its lightness to reduce physical burden of anglers. Some models of Ultimo does not suit to popper with large cup face. So please refer to chart table of lures on page 33 for making sure.




DecanRidge Static load comparison of Ocean Ridge series (6kg load)



The Ocean Ridge series have been designed specifically to target GTs. The stiff tip section has enabled use with various lures depending on the skill of the angler. All models have the power to go head to head with monstrous GTs and are capable to cater for different fighting styles. The most powerful rod in the series are the GT80 and 79 which will require some strength and body weight in the angler to bring forth the rods true potential. Please refer to the "recor body weight" to give you an idea of which rod may suit you.


Type of popper for GT Rods








You can see the comparison between the 5 models in the Ocean Arrow, Selfish series with a static load of 3 kg. The 622S, 613S and 614S are the most standard models in the series with 613S being the most versatile rod, able to ierk iigs around 120g in water less than 100m deep while naturally drifting the boat. The 614S and 615S are designed much stiffer and are more suited for vertical jigging with the boat positioned above the point. The belly section of the 654S and 655S are more flexible most suited for jigging on a diagonal angle in shallow areas. More specifically, the 654S is user-friendlier while the 655S being more suited for areas with extreme water movement and larger size fish. In addition, the Ocean Arrow 5 series are specialized short overhead reel rods designed with the tenacity to target the large species lurking in the deep zone.


Here are the comparisons of the Ocean Arrow, Snapper series with a static load of 1kg. The power of the butt sections are basically the same for the 67UL and 65L designed for use with the Tai-rubber. However, you will notice the difference when you start retrieving and once the rod is loaded with a fish. The 67UL is flexible at the tip section with a contrastingly strong butt while the 65L will absorb the impact with the whole rod. The 66ML is a totally different rod compared to the 67UL and the 65L designed for use with Inchiku and light jigging with a unique grip joint section. The following comparative diagram will give you an idea of the difference in power, however it is not indicating that the 67UL and 65L are weak. The designs of the blanks themselves differ between those rods that are designed to fight with a thin line than to rods to aggressively stop the fish.

About joint section of rod

The joint section of rod of Ripple Fisher has been adjusted with high precision. If ferrule wax have been put on or connect rods without wiping salt water off, might cause of fixation. Please make sure that fouling or moistures are wiped off when you connect.
