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Exploring Uncharted Territory with Curiosity

How many rugged, unexplored areas remain on the Earth that are hostile to humans? <Explanation of Ripple Fisher's Jigging Rods>

Ripple Fisher's jigging category will consist of three categories, including Selfish, Ocean Arrow, and the newly added Agile, which will be available in the fall of 2025. Each series has its own characteristics and bending depending on the anglers purpose and target. This page explains in detail the characteristics of each series for your reference when choosing a rod.



Characteristics of each series of Ripple Fisher's Jigging Models

OceanArrow SELFISH

Selfish series is divided into categories that can be used for three different actions: bouncing the jig, swimming, and lightly maneuvering. All categories are equipped with the sensitivity to decipher the slightest changes in the current for anglers to control the action of the lure for that instantaneous moment. Rather than seeking the performance of light one-pitch jerking, we were after rods which allow anglers to enjoy the process of technical jigging maneuvers by sensing for the changes under the water. We proudly recommend the Selfish series for anglers who wish to delve deeper into the technical jigging game.

OceanArrow

The Ocean Arrow series has a taper design that provides power and strength required for serious battles with sizeable fish. This series consists of three categories, the BFT, DTT and AMJ. The BFT is characterized by a "fight oriented" design that emphasizes the anglers ability to fight comfortably. The DTT, which is characterized by a "high-powered" design that can forcibly stop the powerful fish busting you off on the reef. And the AMJ, which is characterized by a "multi-purpose" rod that provides torque with a light feel to it.

OceanArrow AGILE

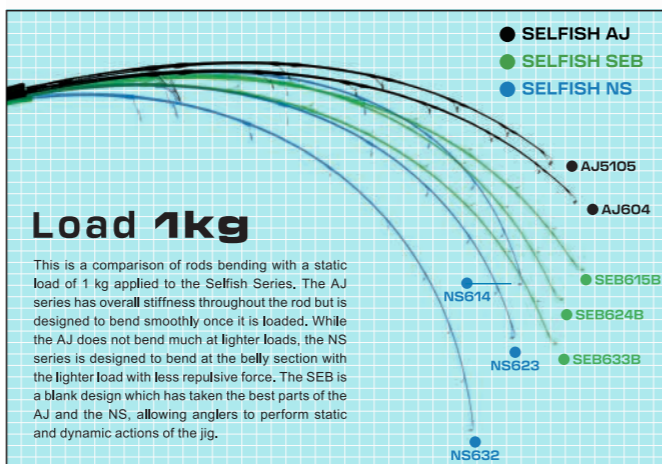
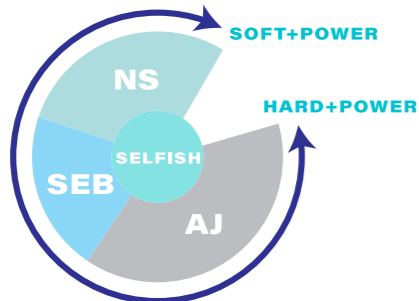
The new Agile series was developed to allow anglers to further enjoy jigging through the use of lighter line setups. There are no restrictions on the field or target and the anglers imagination and technique can bring out infinite possibilities with these rods. All rods in the series and built up of blanks which are highly versatile allowing anglers to maximize the benefits of light lines. You may choose it as your main weapon or as a spare tackle for your more exotic expeditions.

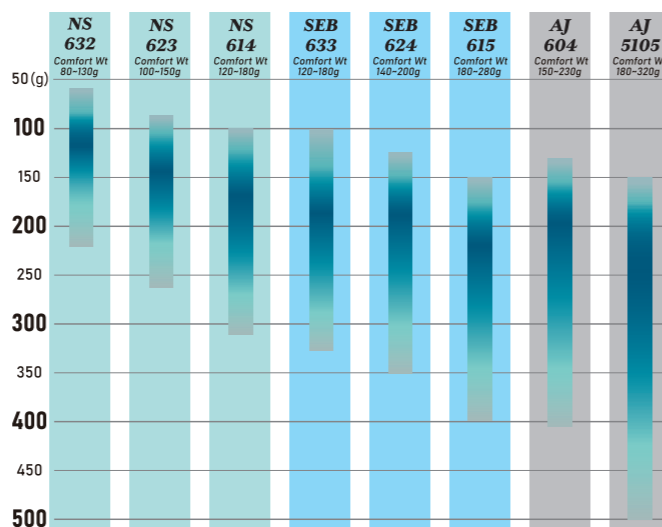
Characteristics of Selfish series

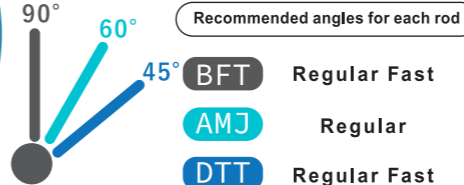
*The comfort weight described in the SELFISH series is considered to be the most manageable weight, but actually, it is possible to use a wider variety of weights. Please refer to the graph below.



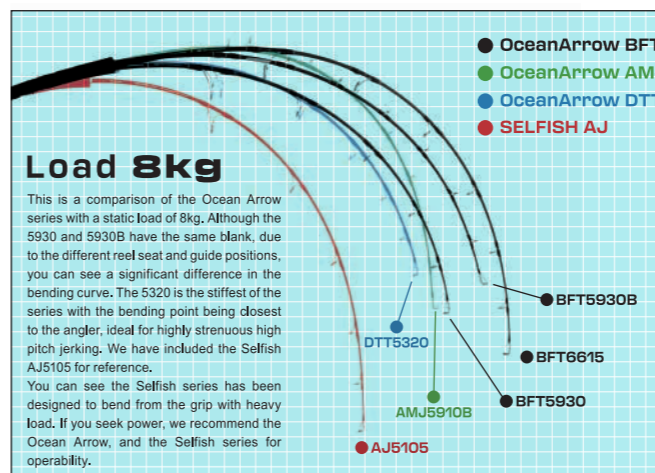
In the table above, the darker the colour gets, the easier it is to use the rod. For jigging, the ideal jig weight will vary depending on the depth, shape of jig, and tidal condition, so please use this as a reference only. Since the stiffness in the AJ series is strong, anglers will be able to utilize lighter jigs when the tidal pressure is low with the minimum output of the rod action. The NS series can be used for swimming actions of lighter jigs in shallow areas with little water pressure with the belly section of the rod while the butt section will help anglers maneuver heavier jigs.

When the fish is far away and the line is slanted, depending on the stiffness and tenacity of the rod series, it is possible to hold the rod up to the angle shown in the diagram above and apply pressure to the fish. If the fish is close to under the boat, please try not to set the rod too high. If you do so while the fish turning under the boat, a huge load will be applied to the blanks and it may cause of breakage. Please do not keep the rod too high angle, especially when landing, so control the fish by holding the rear grip under the arm.

Agile was created to enjoy the subdivided game of light jigging in a Ripple Fisher like way. Even if it is called light jigging collectively, it is not easy to cover all of them due to the types of lures and regional characteristics. What we wanted from Agile was to use application rather than expertise, and not to limit the degree of freedom of the angler. Adapt to the situation with a wide variety of lures and enjoy the wide and deep world of light jigging.

BFT BLUE FIN TUNA

A model designed specifically for bluefin tuna. The 5930 is effective for luring your target with heavy drag jigs and inducing bites through free falling of the jig. If the tides are not cooperative and complex, you can use the 6615 to lightly cast your jig. In addition, the rod can be high stuck during a fight to reduce the stress on the angler for long gruelling fights. The rod feels like the BIG TUNA casting rod but the short length of the rod allows for an easier fight for the angler. However, you must be careful not to apply too much pressure with lighter line class as the power of the rod may cause a line breakage.

AMJ AMBERJACK

A model designed for multiple targets such as amberjack, yellowfin tuna and grouper. It combines easy handling of jigs in deep areas while being able to withstand the powerful thrashing of large species. Compared to the DTT, the rod has less stiffness and will allow anglers to easily handle jigs while being tenacious for various species in the depth. As the rod bends tenaciously compared to the Selfish series, you can differentiate your style of fishing.

DTT DOGTOOTH TUNA

A model designed specifically for bluefin tuna. It boasts overwhelming blank rigidity to apply maximum pressure on the bluefin tuna that swim straight towards the rocks. In addition, by making it a short length rod, it allows lighter handling of heavy jigs. We recommend you choose the DTT when targeting large fish at drop-offs and points with rouged rocks, and BFT for deep areas with relatively flat bottoms.

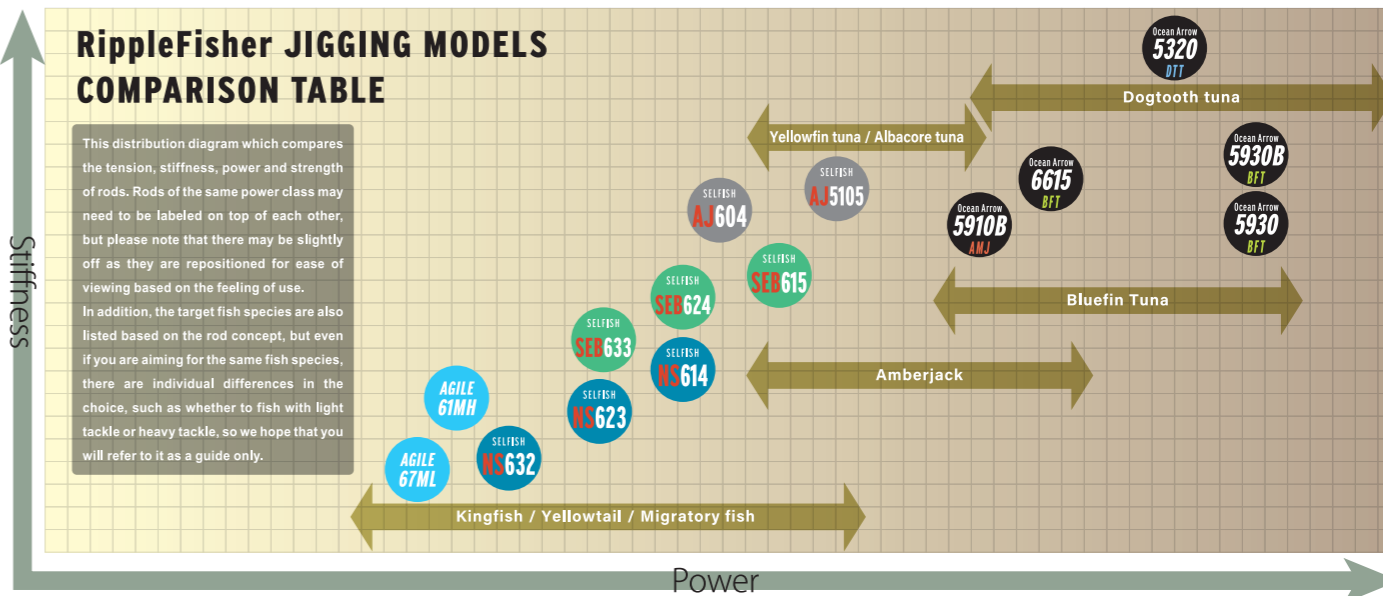
To get to know OceanArrow more

- The Ocean Arrow has very strong torque and outstanding butt power compared to the Selfish. Therefore, we recommend the Selfish series for anglers who easily tire from jigging all day and the Ocean Arrow series for those who need to stop the violent species from busting you off on rocks or areas with massive sharks.
- The Ocean Arrow BFT series is designed for anglers to high-stick the rod during the fight. In addition, the rod end is designed with a special gimbal allowing easier jerking of heavy weight jigs from the fighting belt. Depending on the situation and jig weight, anglers can jig from your armpit or from the gimbal.

This distribution diagram which compares the tension, stiffness, power and strength of rods. Rods of the same power class may need to be labeled on top of each other, but please note that there may be slightly off as they are repositioned for ease of viewing based on the feeling of use. In addition, the target fish species are also listed based on the rod concept, but even if you are aiming for the same fish species, there are individual differences in the choice, such as whether to fish with light tackle or heavy tackle, so we hope that you will refer to it as a guide only.

To perform the ideal action

When it comes to jigging, casting distance is not an issue. It is generally the elevation or sinking of your jig that attract the fish and you can vary your jerking or alternate the speed of your jig. Jigging is so simply yet profound. It is interesting as your fishing results vary greatly depending on your technique and the high reproducibility of your results. How can you set yourself apart from your fellow anglers on board? It's a good idea to look for patterns and try different methods and techniques. By feeling the invisible changes in the sea and interpreting them, you can add action to the jig, and lure the fish. This is the real challenge and fun of jigging.

Ripple Fisher's jigging rod series "SELFISH" is a series that places emphasis on fully enjoying jigging and the process of catching fish. This rod series can be used easily all day, with excellent operability and sensitivity. After the fish is hooked, the slender yet highly resilient blank bends as a whole, lifting the fish quickly while suppressing the fish's thrust. The AJ (Aggressive Jerk), a new category in the SELFISH series in 2025, is characterized by its high jig operability and highly responsive blank. These rods are good at giving accent to the action through stillness and motion of your jig while feeling for the movement of the currents. This series allows the angler to use the rods at their will and enjoy the whole process of jigging as a whole.

The NS rods allows you to move the jigs naturally while the SEB rods are designed for technical maneuvering with bait-casting set ups. The SELFISH series consists of these three subdivided categories and are rods that will allow you to enjoy a variety of jigging techniques.

SELFISH AJ / Aggressive Jerk

The Aggressive Jerk series excels at high speed and sliding action jigs. These specialized models allow the angler to tirelessly do vertical jigging without losing the sensitivity even in deep waters or areas with fast flowing currents.

2025 NEW SELFISH AJ 604

This model allows you to take advantage of the rod's repulsion and high action response without exerting unnecessary force. This is especially helpful in areas with fast flowing currents. It is also able to bring about reaction bites from super high speed jerking with your spinning setup or pinpoint jigging on top of manmade fishing reefs and physically stopping them from busting you off.

2025 NEW SELFISH AJ 5105

This is a high-resilience model specialized for vertical jigging in areas with fast flowing currents at depths of 100m or more. While it is a highly powerful rod, it also retains the light maneuverability of the SELFISH series and high sensitivity to gauge the tidal pressure. Even when aiming pinpoint on rough terrain or around manmade fishing reefs, the short length rod allows for a quick response while boasting outstanding butt power for hooking fish in deep areas. Anglers will be able to comfortably fight massive species and areas where there are plentiful sharks.

SELFISH SEB / Sensitive Bait

These are highly responsive overhead reel models able to easily maneuver jigs simply or technically with various jerking methods. Anglers will be able to easily vary the tempo and speed of jerks capitalizing on the advantages of the overhead reel tackle set up.

2025 NEW SELFISH SEB 615

It is a bait model that supports a wide range of methods, such as pinpoint targeting in the fast flowing currents and deep waters, as well as loose action involving fine pitch adjustment unique to bait-casting reels. At depths of 100 m or more, the belly to butt section of the rod can be used as a fulcrum to bring out the high repulsive force of the blank allowing for a more lively action of your jig. Despite having a slender blank, it has enough butt power to control the intense running of the fish during the fight.

SELFISH SEB 633

The standard model of the SELFISH Overhead reel series - built up with controllability and sensitivity as the foundation - is equipped with the ability to handle various jerking patterns vital for overhead reel setups and blank settings which support the angler when reeling up a heavy load. By eliminating the wobbling of the blank after the jerk and giving it moderate stiffness, the rod responds well in high-pitch or combination jerks. In addition, anglers are also able to utilize slow tempo jerks which focus on the falling of the jig to induce the bite. Once the blank is loaded, the rods bends over nicely and the resilience will allow the angler to take initiative. This versatile rod is the standard model of the series ideal for vertical or diagonal jigging in your local waters or exotic fishing trips.

SELFISH SEB 624

With the basic characteristics of the SEB633, we have set the bending point farther towards the tip and sharpened its manual maneuverability. The strength of the blank is capable of sharply maneuvering jigs up to 220g. This model is built with highly sensitive characteristics and to easily control the jigs and induce a bite when the angler can feel for a fish in pursuit, change in the layer of current or a subtle bite. The reinforced butt power will control the massive thrashing of the fish running towards artificial fish reefs and rough rock formations while the powerful resilience and reeling by the angler will crank up 10kg class Kingfish.

SELFISH NS / Natural Swim

A series especially designed to naturally maneuver the jig by eliminating any unnecessary flicking and jumping of the jig. The versatile multi purpose models are able to induce bites in selective situations, various sea conditions and areas.

SELFISH NS 632

This is a technical model for anglers to utilize small jigs weighing between 80g~130g with PE#2 for those spooked targets or high pressure fields. The light maneuverability and its honed sensitivity will transmit the signal for the bite and allow the angler to efficiently control the jig. Although it is equipped with a quick handling feel, the blank is designed to bend a little when jerking the jig reducing unwanted bouncing and the loss of tension, allowing for a natural action of your jig. Even with the PE#2 class specs, the rod possesses ample butt power not only for local waters but also for trips targeting larger species. The natural action of your lure induced by the light class rod is an ideal selection for the Kingfish suspending in the mid range during the high pressure spring seasons.

SELFISH NS 623

This is a model developed with the focus on its ability to intrigue your target by the natural action of the jig. It is designed to reduce your jig from bouncing about to perform a more natural appeal. While retaining the manual operational feel, anglers will be able to maintain the balance of the jig during its swimming action vital for inducing the bite. The responsive blank will allow anglers to easily switch the jerking pattern from the swimming type jerks using the tip section to those sliding type jerks which use the rebounding of the belly section. You could say that this would be your multi purpose model for local waters, able to smoothly adjust to tough field conditions. The butt section is tenacious and will allow anglers to go head to head with 10kg+ yellowtails (Buri) or 7~8kg Kingfish.

SELFISH NS 614

The NS614 is a technical model designed for fishing in shallow waters between 20~40m in depth, targeting the selective adult kingfish. It is a highly sensitive model, with a flexible tip section while having a stiff belly section to feel for the action of the jig in the water. Anglers will be able to slide and control the jig by efficiently responding to the ever changing sea conditions, and control the thrashing of the monstrous kingfish with the grip-end under your armpits. It is also suitable to under-cast your lure to search a wider area and will respond quickly to those situations where the current is flowing towards you. This piece possesses numerous traits required for jigging in shallow waters.

About Comfort Weight

When inputting action to a jig, the load on the rod will vary depending on the jig weight, water depth, and the speed of the tide. Therefore, for SELFISH, we have indicated a range of jig weights that will not impair action input under any circumstances. Since this is not the maximum weight of jigs, slight fluctuations in the lower and upper limits are not a problem. Please judge the day's conditions such as wind and tide, then pick the appropriate jig weight.

OceanArrow / Jigging for Monster

Tuna / Marlin / Amberjack / Grouper

The Ocean Arrow series is for jigging large species anywhere in the world. For jigging, it is imperative to be able to maneuver the jig to induce the bite. However, when targeting supersize fish, you not only need to be able to induce that bite through your jig control but also be able to withstand the power and lift the monstrous species from the depths. From 2025, the Ocean Arrow series will be subdivided into three categories, and the necessary elements will be adjusted according to the target to create a more sophisticated lineup. In order to fight endurance species like bluefin tuna, BFT pursues a combination of tenacity and strength that would allow anglers to fight comfortably for a long time. On the other hand, the DTT is a model that emphasizes tension and power to stop powerful species (ie. Dogtooth tuna) that run you off on underwater canyons. The AMJ is a medium-heavy model that is easy to handle, while having a reassuring butt power against amberjack and large rock fish.

OceanArrow BFT / Bluefin Tuna

Specializing in tuna that allows you to keep the rod high angle during fights and easily endure long fights.

Target : Tuna / Billfish Category : Heavy Class

OceanArrow 6615

This is a two piece grip jointed spinning model designed to jig for large Tuna. Similar to the 5930, it is designed so anglers can high-stick the rod and the longer rod length is set to avoid the line from scraping the hull of the boat resulting in a break off. Although it is a PE6 class high powered jigging rod, the light feel of the rod will allow anglers to utilize various jerking patterns to induce that bite. The 6615 is a rod that will be useful in various locations around the world and for various species with power to control the thrashing fish, tenacity to continue to apply pressure on the fish and highly well balanced to maneuver the jigs.

Recommended size of tuna: Up to 50 kg

OceanArrow 5930

This is a one piece spinning model designed to jig for large size Tuna and Marlins around the world. The short length rod able to be high sticked will be advantageous for the angler at critical times when the fish is directly beneath the boat. The beautiful bending curve of the one piece blank allows anglers to maintain the high stick position which will continuously apply high pressure on the fish while reducing the load on the angler side. It is ideal for slow pitch jerk, one pitch jerk and other jerking patterns focusing on the sinking action of the heavy weight jigs. Anglers can also utilize the fighting belt to jerk or set the grip end under your armpits.

Recommended size of tuna: More than 50 kg

2025 NEW OceanArrow 5930B

This is a one-piece bait model for targeting tuna. The blank is the same as the 5930 spinning, and the stiffness has increased by making it a bait casting model. This model features a regular tapered action, which is suitable not only for vertical jigging, but also for live bait fishing and trolling. Even when jigging in strong currents or deep trenches, anglers will be able to comfortably utilize long jigs of 200 ~ 800g.

Recommended size of tuna: More than 50 kg

OceanArrow AMJ / Amberjack

A highly versatility that can be used for amberjack, yellowfin tuna, and large grouper.

Target : Amberjack, Large groupers, etc. Category : Medium Heavy Class

2025 NEW OceanArrow 5910B

This is a grip jointed two-piece bait-casting model designed for various species such as amberjack and grouper. It is highly portable and allows anglers to swiftly jerk their jigs in fast flowing currents of exotic fishing destinations. It is also equipped with outstanding butt power to stop the fish from running you off on the rocks.

OceanArrow DTT / Dogtooth Tuna

A category aiming for monsters with outstanding blank rigidity and lift speed.

Target : Dogtooth Tuna Category : Heavy Class

2025 NEW OceanArrow 5320

It is a regular fast-taper action model designed to target monster-sized dogtooth tuna. This rod has strong overall stiffness and a very high action response thanks to its short length, making it possible to operate heavy jigs lightly even in strong currents. It is equipped with ample butt power to forcibly stop fish that run towards the rocks during a fight. We recommend anglers to put their weight behind the rod during the fight to maximize its potential.

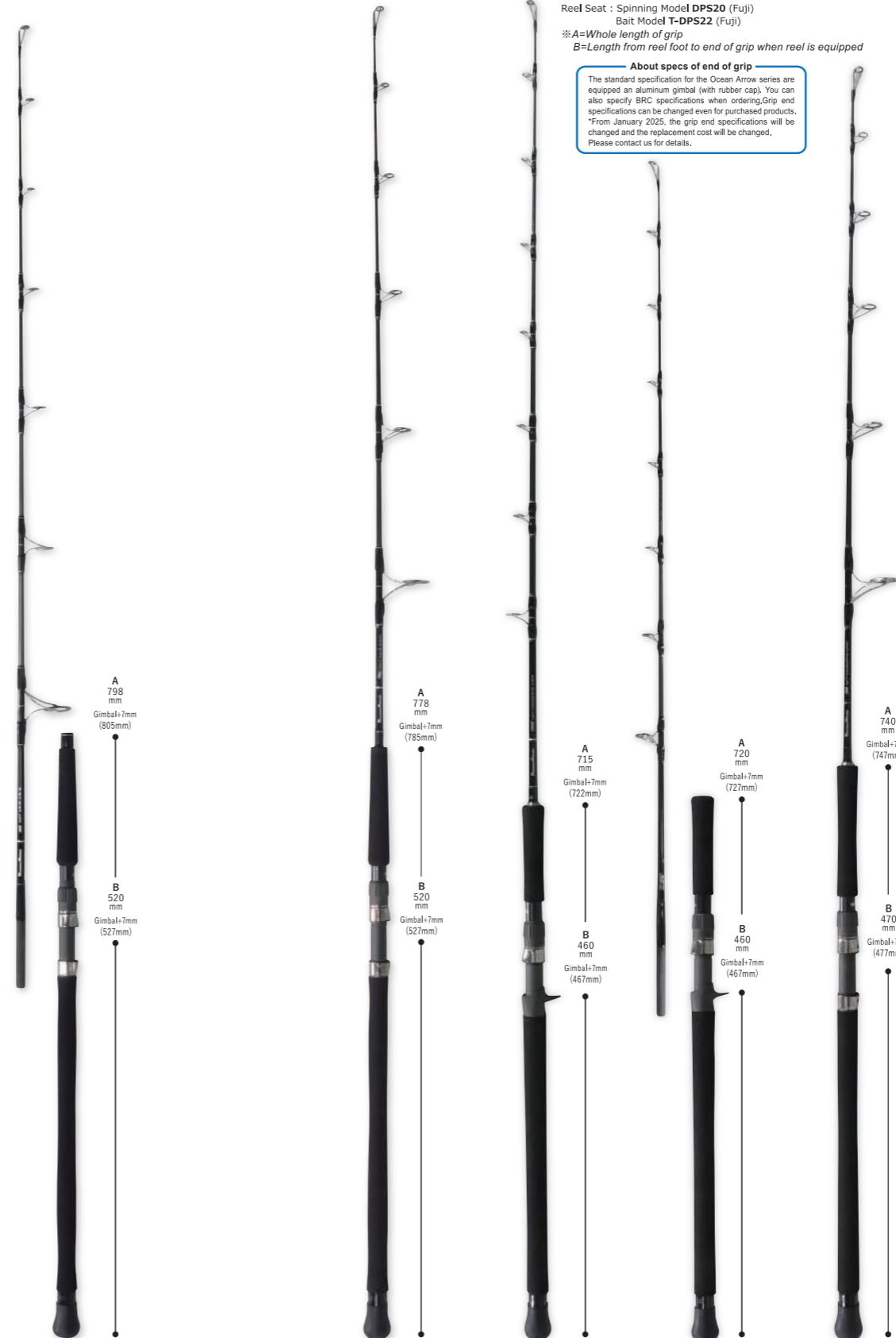

The Aquila series is mainly for targeting kingfish, yellowfin tuna, and mackerel, and is in the middle class power of Ripple Fisher's offshore lineup. The series is divided into four categories: the "MLT" for small bait patterns, the "MST" for large bait patterns, the "ST" for the super sharp blanks, and the "EX" for multi piece models.

The BIG TUNA series is characterized by its resilient blanks that have the torque and power required to fight large bluefin tuna to yellowfin tuna. The Ultimo series is designed for using diving pencils and diving poppers to target GT and large yellowtail. It has a flexible tip, which enables anglers to easily control lures without them jumping out of the surface, and the high versatility allows you to use a wide variety of lures. In addition, the powerful 4 models in the lineup will allow anglers to put their body weight behind the rod to expedite their fight against your monstrous targets.

The GTX series is a 3 piece pack rod series for targeting GT and large kingfish. It is a highly versatile design that can handle a variety of lures, from poppers to diving pencils. 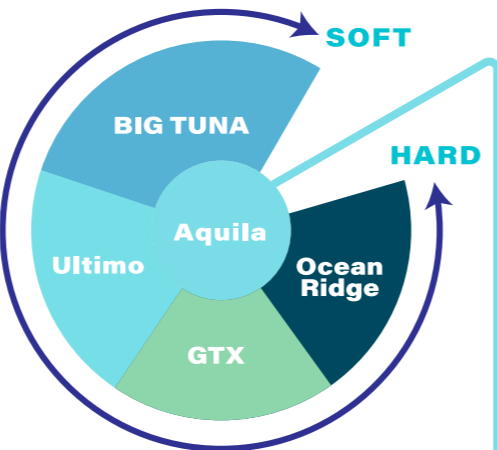

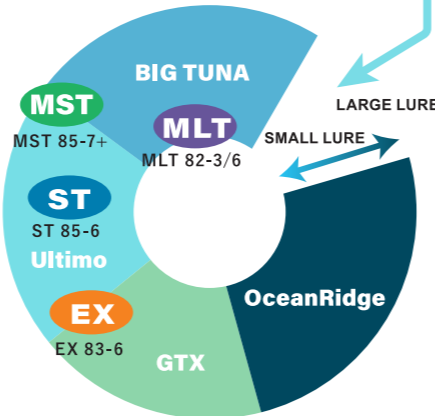

We recommend using different rods according to the bait pattern and target size of the BIG TUNA series, but here we will explain how to choose a rod that suits your strength and how to position yourself to maximize the blank's performance. *For detailed characteristics of each model, please see the BIG TUNA page.

BIG TUNA FIGHT STYLE

Slow Fight

Use a rod that will bend deeply. Hold the rod upright and use the blank's bending force to slowly bring the fish to the surface. Recommended for those with less body weight or physical strength.

Speedy Fight

For those who are confident in physical strength or who have sufficient body weight, it is recommended to use a stiffer rod which will have a shallower bend for a speedier fight.

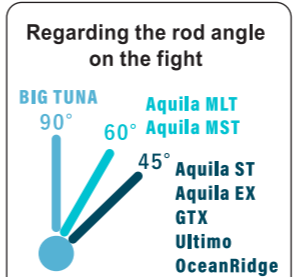

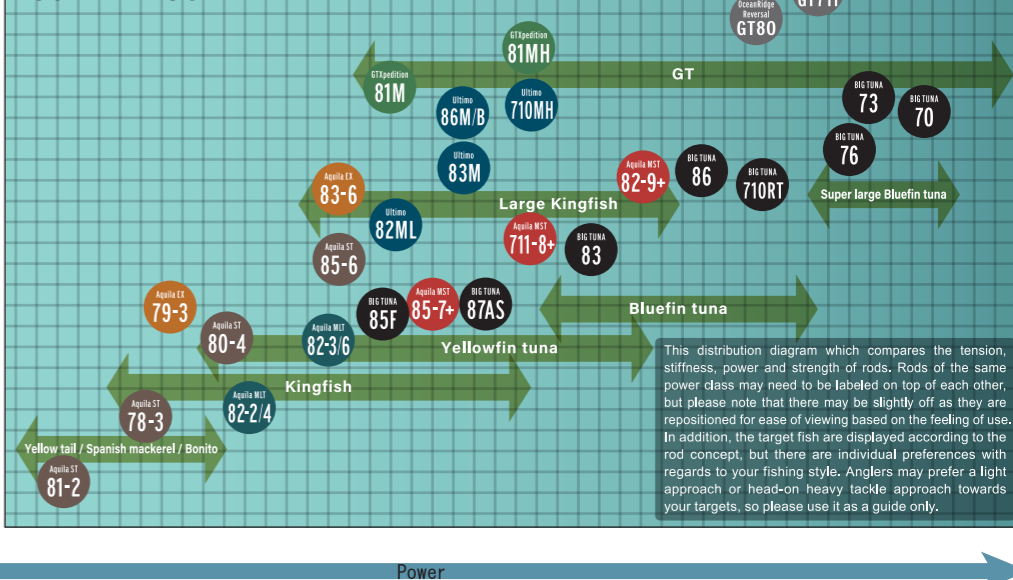

When the fish is far away and the line is slanted, depending on the stiffness and tenacity of the rod series, it is possible to hold the rod up to the angle shown in the diagram above and apply pressure to the fish. If the fish is close to under the boat, please try not to set the rod too high. If you do so while the fish turning under the boat, a huge load will be applied to the blanks and it may cause of breakage. Please do not keep the rod too high angle, especially when landing, so control the fish by holding the rear grip under the arm.

This distribution diagram which compares the tension, stiffness, power and strength of rods. Rods of the same power class may need to be labeled on top of each other, but please note that there may be slightly off as they are repositioned for ease of viewing based on the feeling of use. In addition, the target fish are displayed according to the rod concept, but there are individual preferences with regards to your fishing style. Anglers may prefer a light approach or head-on heavy tackle approach towards your targets, so please use it as a guide only.

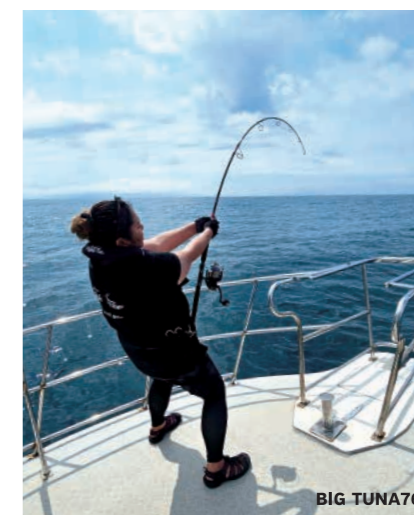

We have set the power category as follows in order for a more comprehensive understanding.

The 86, 710RT, 73, 76, 70 are all in the same line max category however the 73, 76, 70 have been designed with a higher breakage point suited for targeting 200kg class fish which are in a different power category from 86 and 710RT.

The 86 and 710RT models can be used in situations where a long cast is required or more sensitive action is required.

*Please note that aiming huge tuna over 100kg in rough conditions is dangerous. Regarding "models that are designed for extremely large bluefin tuna" such as BIG TUNA73, 76, and 70, the explanations and specifications are written assuming that you have the appropriate physical strength, training, and experience. Thank you for your understanding.

The 85F, 87AS, and 83 models are also useful for targeting yellowfin tuna, and the standard is 85F for tuna size 50kg or less, and 87AS and 83 for tuna size 80kg or less.

Please consider the lure size to be used, the line, the size of the tuna, and the lure appeal required, and choose a model.

*Even though the maximum line value is the same, the set drag value will vary depending on the model, so please keep this in mind when choosing a rod.

*If you are looking for a lighter model than the BIG TUNA series, we also recommend the Aquila series' MLT82-3/6, MST85-7+ and MLT82-3/6 does not have as strong a butt power as the BIG TUNA series, but it has an achievement of catching tuna over 50kg during testing. This model is also recommended for those who want to cast small lures when using ultra-small bait patterns such as whitebait. MST85-7+ has a short length grip, allowing for faster and more agile casting. It has excellent long-distance casting performance, so it is recommended for both shooting to fish feeding on surface and luring out.

The rod design of the BIG TUNA series is color coded with thread colors matching the power class on the left. Also, the model name is engraved on the spacer on the reel sheet of the grip.

BIG TUNA 85F JAPAN Special Light Class

This is a model capable of being high stuck while also being able to cast small lures a great distance. Anglers will be able to utilize lures ranging from 18g~120g and line ranging from PE3~6. We have given this rod a wide range to deal with the high pressure from anglers as well as to induce bites when the Tuna are feeding on small baits. Although it is classed as a light rod in the lineup, you will be able to land 50kg Yellowfin and Bluefin Tuna.

BIG TUNA 87AS JAPAN Special Middle Class

As its name suggests, the AS (Accuracy Shoot) model is designed to accurately cast lures into the feeding fish. In addition to the steady blank kick-back after casting, we have equipped two RV guides on the butt enabling an extremely smooth line ejection from the reel through to the rod. The casting ability will support anglers when the feeding frenzy is far or in heavy conditions casting into the wind. It is not only able to cast large lures but the blank will also allow the use of small 40g size lures. This middle class rod will assist anglers with its taper design ideal to slowly but surely lift the fish from the deep while being able to high-stick the rod.

※If you prefer a more speedy fight (same size fish) we recommend the 83. (87AS is 1 rank lighter compared to the 83. Furthermore, the 87AS is a totally different model and design to the 87 which has been discontinued.)

BIG TUNA 83 JAPAN Special Middle Class

This model was developed with "lure control" and "fight" as its main focus, but it goes without saying that casting is also outstanding. It is a PE6~8 middle class rod not only able to pinpoint cast but also able to utilize small mouthed diving poppers and diving pencils required for an attack. You will be able to realize the evolution of our BIG TUNA series with its lightness and outstanding balance, allowing anglers to cast all day long. Furthermore, the bending point is set close to the body enabling anglers to easily bend in and capitalize on the butt power with little effort.

BIG TUNA 86 JAPAN Special Heavy Class

If you require long and accurate casting with a heavy class tackle, this 86 will be your choice. In comparison to your ordinary heavy tackle, the flexible tip on the 86 will allow for easier casting of smaller lures when the bait-fish are small though the Tuna are huge. The bending point (pivotal point) is closer to the body allowing anglers to take initiative during the fight.

BIG TUNA 710RT JAPAN Special Heavy Class

Compared to the characteristics of the original model, we have re-designed the model to suit the current tuna scene. Since we have designed the taper of the blank to be most productive in the butt section, anglers will be able to efficiently and effectively utilize the butt power to lift the tuna. It's not simply a more flexible model compared to its predecessor, but a highly well-balanced heavy class model able to effortlessly stimulate bites from casting top water lures while having the power to go head to head with the biggest of fish. This will be your ideal model if you are in situations where you need to cast lures all day long.

BIG TUNA 76 JAPAN Special Power Class

This model is for anglers with their sights on Blue-fin tuna weighing over 200kg. Similar to the 73, this 76 is capable of not only casting large lures mostly used when the targets are feeding on dolphin fish (mahi-mahi), but also allows anglers to cast and control the lighter (60g) sinking pencils for smaller baits. The difference from the 73 will be the contrasting fight style. While possessing strong butt power to constantly apply pressure on the fish, we have drastically reduced the load on the angler by bringing the bending point closer to the angler, allowing for a prolonged fight.

BIG TUNA 73 JAPAN Special Power Class

This model is for anglers with their sights on Blue fin tuna weighing over 200kg. Its castability is next to non, able to accurately hit feeding targets with large lures most productive when they are feeding on dolphin fish (mahi mahi). Being short in length and the stiffest model in the series, it is most suited for anglers who have confidence in their strength and ability to go head to head with the monstrous tuna.

BIG TUNA 70 JAPAN Special Power Class

This is for those anglers with their sights on super monstrous Blue-fin tuna. It is model for anglers who need to "high-stick the rod" to load the blank or utilize the "straight pumping" fight style. The power of the rod is similar to the BT76 and BT73 but the breaking point is much greater compared to these two. With the shorter designed blank, the bending point is set closer to the body, drastically reducing the load and stress on the angler. It also has enough length and leverage to go around the bow or other obstacles on the boat for a smoother fight.

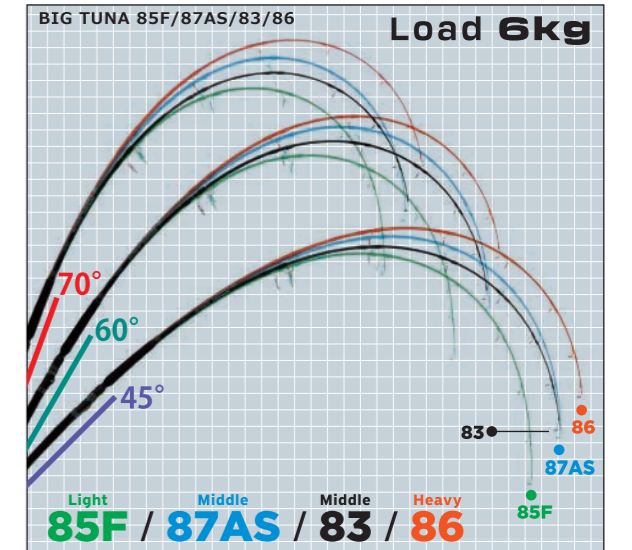

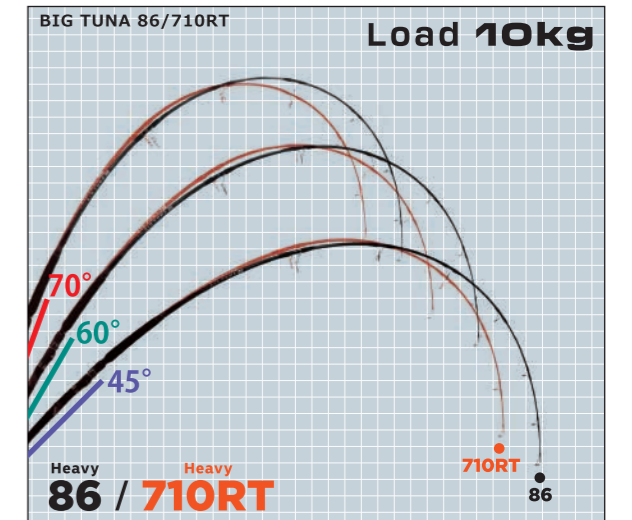

BIG TUNA Bending Curve

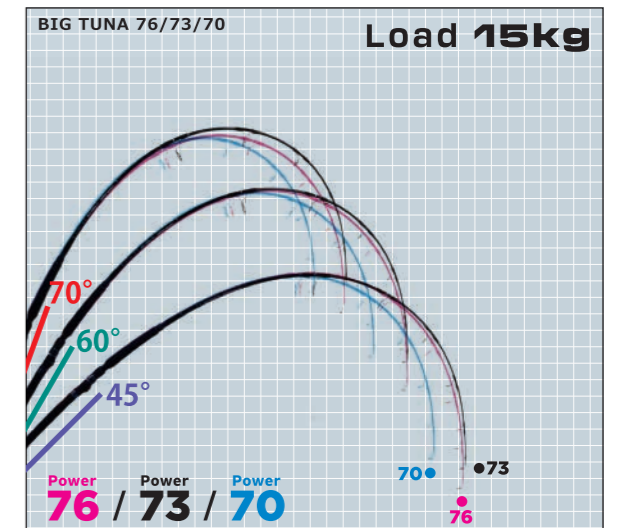

The illustration shows the comparison of the 2 heavy class rods. Both rods have a similar taper design but the difference lies in the length. By utilizing the length of the 86 blank, anglers will be able to cast farther than other shorter rods while the shorter 710RT is a model able to load the blank with the weight of the fish with ease.



The picture illustrates the comparison of the 3 power class models. When looking at the comparison with a 45 degree angle, the 73 and 76 look similar, however, the bending point of the 76 is closer to the angler, reducing the stress on the angler, while the 73 is further away enabling a more speedy fight against the fish. The 70 has the strongest butt power with the bending point being close to the angler, drastically reducing the load on the angler. The three models are the same power class, yet having totally different characteristics.
