The key to success in high-pressure waters is the ability to clearly interpret subtle changes in the currents, changes in topography and structure, and to quickly detect these changes. The Stiletto MX, constructed exclusively from high-modulus carbon, features an ultra-highly-sensitive blank achieved by relentlessly eliminating unnecessary material. This enables the rod to sharply detect even the slightest variations in water flow and lure load. You could say that this is an expert model where its true values will be demonstrated in selective situations when the fish are inactive. Although it is not an easy-to-use series, the deliberate elimination of the automatic elements in a rod, fully brings out the angler's senses and techniques. Every action—whether “maneuvering” the lure or letting it “pause”—becomes precisely refined, making this a master-grade rod worthy of the name “Master-Exclusive.”

While comfortably controlling minnows weighing around 28g, its sharp sensitivity and delicate maneuverability allow anglers to utilize sinking pencil type lures around 8g for micro-bait patterns. Optimized for high-precision casting in daytime sessions, reading subtle current changes while wading in the dark and capitalizing on the smallest bites when faced with inactive fish. When conditions get tough, the ultra-highly sensitive 81 Stiletto MX is in its element. The ultra-high sensitivity of the 81 Stiletto MX is at its best in challenging situations. (This updated model builds upon the original 81 Stiletto with refined performance.)

The 100 Stiletto MX has been meticulously refined to deliver overwhelming long-distance casting performance for efficiently covering vast fields such as large rivers, shallow rocky shores, and open-ocean surf zones, while also providing the robust torque needed to handle heavyweight, powerful trophy-class seabass.The highly modulus blank provides a crisp casting feel, allowing for a wide range of lures, including large minnows, heavy drag wake baits, and jig minnows, ensuring accurate delivery of your lure even in adverse headwind conditions. The highly responsive tip section, engineered with its excellent reeling sensitivity, accurately transmits even the slightest signals, such as current changes and lure drag, maintaining clear sensitivity even when the lure is at a distance. It also responds well to delicate maneuvering of small lures weighing around 12g. When fishing long distances across expansive waters, the 100 Stiletto MX offers the series' highest level of casting performance and precise control, allowing you to seize moment.

2026 NEW SilverStream 911B Stiletto MX

By integrating the series' signature crisp sensitivity and delicate operability into a highly versatile baitcasting platform, this rod further elevates the potential of the Stiletto MX series. Featuring a highly-modulus blank of the series, it delivers an exceptionally manual, angler-driven feel, enabling precise control across varying depth ranges from the surface to the bottom. It handles a wide spectrum of lures with outstanding accuracy—from small minnows around 15 g to heavyweight big minnows and jointed-lures up to approximately 2 oz in weight—allowing anglers to go after monstrous seabass. 
Reel seat

The reel seat features a hybrid design combining a Fuji SKDPS with our original custom wood insert. This wooden component eliminates the uncomfortable gaps often found in skeleton seats, creating a seamless, ergonomic profile that fits naturally in the palm. This design significantly reduces hand fatigue during the repetitive casting required in seabass fishing, offering the perfect balance of sophisticated aesthetics and practical functionality.



Front grip

Models 95, 100, and 911B feature a custom wooden foregrip equipped with an integrated hook keeper at the top end. This rubber-lined hole allows you to securely stow your hook, making it ideal for quick spot changes or for positioning your lure alongside a trophy Seabass for photos.

This technical model has been refined to the utmost to deliver exceptional casting accuracy for close-range fishing, such as boat seabass fishing, small scale rivers, and structure fishing in the inner bay areas. The Apis series have consistently strong stiffness throughout the blanks, resulting in the sharp sensitivity and response unique to short length rods. The rod that faithfully responds to the angler's intentions, truly embodies the concept “control at will” , demonstrating outstanding control to send lures precisely into the intended spots - at the edge of structure, on the edge of the light/darkness of streetlights, and deep into standing posts and berths. In contrast to the power-oriented game envisioned by the Big-Bait series, these rods have been developed for the more delicate approach for both boat and land-based casting.





Centered on boat seabass fishing, the 72 Apis is also ideal for light casting targeting small migratory species such as Spanish mackerel and mahi-mahi with jigs or blade-baits, as well as for technical land-based casting that relies on finesse tactics around inner bays and seawalls. The 72 Apis is an essential tool for anglers who prioritize precise control and tactical game development to induce that rare bite.

By combining the direct control and stable retrieval characteristics of baitcasting reels with the delicate blank of the 71B Apis, this rod allows anglers to clearly sense changes in lure posture and underwater resistance. SilverStream BIG BAIT / Big Bait Game

Big bait fishing is the ultimate strategy when predators lock onto large forage like Gizzard Shad, Sardines, Mullet, and Spent Ayu. This dynamic style, whether from boat or shore, continues to captivate anglers worldwide. Driven by pioneering anglers pushing the limits, this game has evolved beyond Seabass to target species like the mullet-eating Akame (Japanese Lates), the northern monster Japanese Taimen, and Lake Trout.

The Silver Stream Big Bait Series is designed to manipulate large to super-giant lures ranging from 1.5 to 10oz, offering a multi-faceted approach to this thrilling game. In direct contrast to the Apis series, which specializes in delicate precision, this series is dedicated to the raw power game—built to cast boldly and dominate fights in both boat and land-based game.

SilverStream 60 BIG PENCIL

This rod is designed to target seabass off-shore with the use of big-bait lures. Anglers will be able to cast and maneuver large pencils easily to induce bites from seabass feeding on massive bait fish during specific seasons of the year. We are also planning to release a long-handle (sold separately). By attaching the long-handle, anglers will be able to easily cast and use the rod from the bow of the boat, in addition for use with land-based fishing.
(The length of the rod with the long-handle will be 6.9ft)



The whole length will be 6ft 9inch when the long handle is equipped. The length from the trigger to the end of the grip will be extended 115mm, and to the top of the front grip will be extended 95mm. If you are required distance cast or wish to have more stability when you manipulate lure or fight with big fish, this long handle will support you, don't matter from shore or offshore.

SilverStream 74 GIANT BAIT

The 74 is a special model able to cast out super giant baits exceeding 300mm and 250g. The 74 is approximately two levels more powerful compared to the 60. While being able to overhead cast super size joint baits, anglers are also able to lightly control smaller 3oz lures. It is ideal to maneuver joint baits with the sharp rod action and will outperform most rods off-shore and land based.





This model is ideal to cast metal jigs and jig minnows up to 50g in weight from rocky headlands and technical rock formations, which require a quick and tricky cast and retrieve. With its sharp characteristics, anglers will be able to cast accurately while controlling the jig at ease. Having said that, the rod will bend nicely once the rod is loaded and will prevent any loss of fish from the targets lip ripping. Furthermore, it possesses the butt power to aggressively stop the violent fish from diving into the rocks and structures.

SilverStream 112 Northern

The 112 Northern is a sharp rod designed for long distance casting and will enable anglers to cast out metal jigs and jig minnows up to 60g from the surf and other major points by utilizing the whole rods repulsive force in strong head and side winds. With its high sensitivity, this rod will become your ultimate weapon when the fish are far and you need to search a vast area. Furthermore, the long rod length will help you avoid any rocks or structures nearby and it also possesses the butt power to rip off the monstrous flounders from the seabed.

The six main models are designed to target pelagic species such as yellowtails, amberjack, and kingfish, which easily exceed the 10 kg mark. 






ROCKY SHORE CASTING MODELS COMPARISON TABLE





It retains the advantage for jig heads in the 1~2g range as well. However, the RC-65 offers vastly superior usability for plugs around 3g and other light rigs. 
Short Length Light Game Model Comparison




Black sea bream & Seabass Game Model Comparison




Seabass Game Model Comparison




Seabass Game Bait Model Comparison





SELFISH

Selfish series is divided into categories that can be used for three different actions: bouncing the jig, swimming, and lightly maneuvering. All categories are equipped with the sensitivity to decipher the slightest changes in the current for anglers to control the action of the lure for that instantaneous moment. Rather than seeking the performance of light one-pitch jerking, we were after rods which allow anglers to enjoy the process of technical jigging maneuvers by sensing for the changes under the water. We proudly recommend the Selfish series for anglers who wish to delve deeper into the technical jigging game.



*Static load comparison does not represent all rod characteristics such as repulsion force. There are individual differences in how the load is applied when actually bending the rod, so please use this as a guide only.

<Explanation of Ripple Fisher's Jigging Rods>
Ripple Fisher's jiggng category comprises three distinct series: the Selfish, the Ocean Arrow, and the newly added Agile.Each series is engineered with unique characteristics and actions, tailored to specific fishing styles and purposes. This page provides a detailed explanation of the features and actions of each series to assist you in selecting the rod that best suits your needs.

SELFISH 3CATEGORIES

NS Natural Swim

Specialized for drift jigging

Specialized for situations where fish respond well to swimming-action jigs. This series is also designed to handle scenarios involving the frequent use of lightweight or short jigs, as well as shallow jigging strategies that require casting to search wide areas.

SEB SENSitive Bait

Well balanced for Vertical Jigging and Drift Jigging


This series demonstrates its true potential with a diverse range of jigs and patterns, from high-pitch jerking to falling actions. It is specialized for scenarios requiring precise control of the jig falling, such as targeting shallow reef, structure fishing, and Tuna jigging.

AJ Aggressive Jerk

Specialized in vertical jigging

This series excels in patterns where fish respond well to high-appeal actions, such as the sliding motion of long jigs and high-pitch jerking. It is also specialized for situations requiring the use of heavy jigs in deep water or areas with heavy currents, such as the Kuroshio region.

COMPATIBLE JIG WEIGHT QUICK REFERENCE TABLE



For jigging, the ideal jig weight will vary depending on the depth, shape of jig, and tidal condition, so please use this as a reference only. Since the stiffness in the AJ series is strong, anglers will be able to utilize lighter jigs when the tidal pressure is low with the minimum output of the rod action. The NS series can be used for swimming actions of lighter jigs in shallow areas with little water pressure with the belly section of the rod while the butt section will help anglers maneuver heavier jigs.

*The comfort weight described in the SELFISH series is considered to be the most manageable weight, but actually, it is possible to use a wider variety of weights. Please refer to the graph below.


Agile was created to enjoy the subdivided game of light jigging in a Ripple Fisher-like way. Even if it is called light jigging collectively, it is not easy to cover all of them due to the types of lures and regional characteristics. What we wanted from Agile was to use application rather than expertise, and not to limit the degree of freedom of the angler. Adapt to the situation with a wide variety of lures and enjoy the wide and deep world of light jigging.

AGILE 67ML

Specially designed for reeling-focused light jigging strategies.This model is ideal for using Tai-rubber and Tungsten jigs in deep waters (exceeding 100~150m) or strong currents. The sensitive yet highly flexible tip-to-belly section detects subtle changes, allowing fish to bite without feeling unnatural resistance. Despite its pliability, the butt section retains a solid core, providing the power to firmly control and lift unexpected large fish.

AGILE 60MH

A high-response, regular taper model that excels in slow jigging and the intricate manipulation of semi-long jigs.The uniform tension from tip to butt allows for direct, manual-style control over a diverse range of actions—from high-pitch to slow—and accommodates a wide spectrum of jig weights. During the fight, the entire rod bends smoothly, allowing anglers to enjoy thrilling battles with large fish.




The 67ML features a sensitive tip that loads smoothly to detect bites, backed by a powerful butt for critical control. The 60MH, with its moderate tip tension and full-body bend, generates strong recovery force for versatile actions and dominance over large fish. Please view the "ML" and "MH" labels as a difference in operational feel rather than just power classes.




The Ocean Arrow series is engineered with the essential power and strength required for serious battles against large predators. The lineup consists of three distinct categories:
BFT: "fight-focused" design prioritizing the angler's comfort and stability during the battle.
DTT: "high-power" specification built to forcibly stop fish from diving into structures.
AMJ: "multi-purpose" model designed to achieve a balance between ample torque and a light, agile operational feel.
Note: These category names (BFT, DTT, AMJ) are not printed on the rod blanks themselves.

This is a comparison of the Ocean Arrow series with a static load of 8kg. Although the 5930 and 5930B have the same blank, due to the different reel seat and guide positions, you can see a significant difference in the bending curve. The 5320 is the stiffest of the series with the bending point being closest to the angler, ideal for highly strenuous high pitch jerking. We have included the Selfish AJ5105 for reference. You can see the Selfish series has been designed to bend from the grip with heavy load. If you seek power, we recommend the Ocean Arrow, and the Selfish series for operability.

When the fish is far away and the line is slanted, depending on the stiffness and tenacity of the rod series, it is possible to hold the rod up to the angle shown in the diagram above and apply pressure to the fish. If the fish is close to under the boat, please try not to set the rod too high. If you do so while the fish turning under the boat, a huge load will be applied to the blanks and it may cause of breakage. Please do not keep the rod too high angle, especially when landing, so control the fish by holding the rear grip under the arm.

We have illustrated the comparison of various models power/strength versus stiffness/hardness. For similar power class rods, they should overlap but we have slightly shifted the rods for easier viewing, so please keep that in mind.

OceanArrow SELFISH

When it comes to jigging, casting distance is not an issue. It is generally the elevation or sinking of your jig that attract the fish and you can vary your jerking or alternate the speed of your jig. Jigging is so simply yet profound.

It is interesting as your fishing results vary greatly depending on your technique and the high reproducibility of your results. How can you set yourself apart from your fellow anglers on board? It's a good idea to look for patterns and try different methods and techniques. By feeling the invisible changes in the sea and interpreting them, you can add action to the jig, and lure the fish. This is the real challenge and fun of jigging.


Ripple Fisher's jigging rod series "Selfish" is a series that places emphasis on fully enjoying jigging and the process of catching fish. This rod series can be used easily all day, with excellent operability and sensitivity. After the fish is hooked, the slender yet highly resilient blank bends as a whole, lifting the fish quickly while suppressing the fish's thrust.

In 2026, we will be adding three new models to the AJ series, creating a lineup that can handle a wider variety of patterns and changing conditions.

"AJ - Aggressive Jerk" is a series characterized by outstanding response and able to perform dynamic lure control with high sensitivity that allows anglers to detect changes in the current and water pressure.

"NS - Natural Swim" is a series that specializes in high controllability of jigs when the boat is drifting naturally (line on a diagonal angle), allowing the jig to move naturally even in shallow waters or when the current is slow.

A highly maneuverable series that allows for a versatile action of jigs unique to baitcasting tackle, from short/high-pitch jerks to slow styles that induce the bite with the sinking of the jig. "Feel, control and hookup." The Selfish series continues to refine every aspect of jigging, evolving to meet the passion of anglers who continue to explore the unknown.



SELFISH AJ 5105

SELFISH AJ / Aggressive Jerk

The Aggressive Jerk series excels at high speed and sliding action jigs. These specialized models allow the angler to tirelessly do vertical jigging without losing the sensitivity even in deep waters or areas with fast flowing currents.

2026 NEW SELFISH AJ 612

The AJ612, along with the NS632, are two of the Selfish series' most sensitive models, offering even sharper controllability and improved responsiveness. Optimized for jigs up to 150g, the AJ612 offers quick and unrestricted maneuverability. The highly repulsive blank will allow anglers to cut through the water with the fine line and maneuver the jigs at high speed. The series' highest level of sensitivity, picking up on even the slightest changes in the upper and lower currents like an antenna, makes it unbeatable for efficiently identifying the bite zones. In addition, the robust double footed guides will ensure you have control during the sudden encounters with monstrous fish. By fusing exceptional sensitivity for reading current conditions, superior operability, and uncompromising strength, the AJ612 opens new possibilities for local water jigging.

2026 NEW SELFISH AJ 603

The AJ603 builds on the crisp, responsive handling of the AJ612 and has been specifically refined for using jig weights of around 180g which are the generally the main weight for your local waters. Its strong, resilient backbone delivers powerful repulsion, allowing anglers to widely slide their jigs and also conduct high-speed jerks. Even in high-pressure areas where there are many anglers, or during low-activity periods when the flow of the current slows right down and fish are reluctant to bite, the rods explosive initial response delivers crisp action, proving highly effective in triggering strikes from wary fish. The AJ603 best embodies the sharp action and refined sensitivity unique to the Selfish series, while also being equipped with the sturdy double-foot guides. As the standard for your local waters, this new model will serve as a new foundation for anglers, capable of not only vertical jigging but also natural drifting of the boat in shallow areas with the jig and line on a diagonal angle.

2026 NEW SELFISH AJ 5105B

The AJ5105B truly excels in demanding situations where spinning tackle places excessive load on the angler—such as deep jigging over 150 meters in fast-flowing current in southern Japan, or targeting large amberjack on exotic overseas expeditions. Its exceptionally strong blank minimizes power loss even during high-pitch jerks under heavy load in deep water, maintaining a consistent rhythm and delivering sharp, decisive action to draw out trophy-class fish.The reeling strength unique to baitcasting tackle allows you to easily maneuver jigs weighing around 400g, minimizing fatigue even during extended fishing trips and allowing anglers to maintain a stable pitch. This rod boasts overwhelming butt power, allowing you to quickly lift the fish away from structures and maintain full control during the tough fight against the monstrous fish from depths of over 200 meters. Deep-sea jigging becomes more agile and efficient. This is Ripple Fisher's ultimate model, honed for fast-flowing currents, deep jigging, to target your trophy fish. (Same blank as the AJ 5105.)

SELFISH AJ 604

This model allows you to take advantage of the rod's repulsion and high action response without exerting unnecessary force. This is especially helpful in areas with fast flowing currents. It is also able to bring about reaction bites from super high speed jerking with your spinning setup or pinpoint jigging on top of manmade fishing reefs and physically stopping them from busting you off.

SELFISH AJ 5105

This is a high-resilience model specialized for vertical jigging in areas with fast flowing currents at depths of 100m or more. While it is a highly powerful rod, it also retains the light maneuverability of the SELFISH series and high sensitivity to gauge the tidal pressure. Even when aiming pinpoint on rough terrain or around manmade fishing reefs, the short length rod allows for a quick response while boasting outstanding butt power for hooking fish in deep areas. Anglers will be able to comfortably fight massive species and areas where there are plentiful sharks.



SELFISH SEB / Sensitive Bait

These are highly responsive overhead reel models able to easily maneuver jigs simply or technically with various jerking methods. Anglers will be able to easily vary the tempo and speed of jerks capitalizing on the advantages of the overhead reel tackle set up.

SELFISH SEB 633

The standard model of the SELFISH Overhead reel series - built up with controllability and sensitivity as the foundation - is equipped with the ability to handle various jerking patterns vital for overhead reel setups and blank settings which support the angler when reeling up a heavy load. By eliminating the wobbling of the blank after the jerk and giving it moderate stiffness, the rod responds well in high-pitch or combination jerks. In addition, anglers are also able to utilize slow tempo jerks which focus on the falling of the jig to induce the bite. Once the blank is loaded, the rods bends over nicely and the resilience will allow the angler to take initiative. This versatile rod is the standard model of the series ideal for vertical or diagonal jigging in your local waters or exotic fishing trips.

SELFISH SEB 624

With the basic characteristics of the SEB633, we have set the bending point farther towards the tip and sharpened its manual maneuverability. The strength of the blank is capable of sharply maneuvering jigs up to 220g. This model is built with highly sensitive characteristics and to easily control the jigs and induce a bite when the angler can feel for a fish in pursuit, change in the layer of current or a subtle bite. The reinforced butt power will control the massive thrashing of the fish running towards artificial fish reefs and rough rock formations while the powerful resilience and reeling by the angler will crank up 10kg class Kingfish.

SELFISH SEB 615

It is a bait model that supports a wide range of methods, such as pinpoint targeting in the fast flowing currents and deep waters, as well as loose action involving fine pitch adjustment unique to bait-casting reels. At depths of 100 m or more, the belly to butt section of the rod can be used as a fulcrum to bring out the high repulsive force of the blank allowing for a more lively action of your jig. Despite having a slender blank, it has enough butt power to control the intense running of the fish during the fight.

About Comfort Weight

When inputting action to a jig, the load on the rod will vary depending on the jig weight, water depth, and the speed of the tide. Therefore, for SELFISH, we have indicated a range of jig weights that will not impair action input under any circumstances. Since this is not the maximum weight of jigs, slight fluctuations in the lower and upper limits are not a problem. Please judge the day's conditions such as wind and tide, then pick the appropriate jig weight.

A series especially designed to naturally maneuver the jig by eliminating any unnecessary flicking and jumping of the jig. The versatile multi purpose models are able to induce bites in selective situations, various sea conditions and areas.

SELFISH NS 632

This is a technical model for anglers to utilize small jigs weighing between 80g~130g with PE#2 for those spooked targets or high pressure fields. The light maneuverability and its honed sensitivity will transmit the signal for the bite and allow the angler to efficiently control the jig. Although it is equipped with a quick handling feel, the blank is designed to bend a little when jerking the jig reducing unwanted bouncing and the loss of tension, allowing for a natural action of your jig. Even with the PE#2 class specs, the rod possesses ample butt power not only for local waters but also for trips targeting larger species. The natural action of your lure induced by the light class rod is an ideal selection for the Kingfish suspending in the mid range during the high pressure spring seasons.

SELFISH NS 623

This is a model developed with the focus on its ability to intrigue your target by the natural action of the jig. It is designed to reduce your jig from bouncing about to perform a more natural appeal. While retaining the manual operational feel, anglers will be able to maintain the balance of the jig during its swimming action vital for inducing the bite. The responsive blank will allow anglers to easily switch the jerking pattern from the swimming type jerks using the tip section to those sliding type jerks which use the rebounding of the belly section. You could say that this would be your multi purpose model for local waters, able to smoothly adjust to tough field conditions. The butt section is tenacious and will allow anglers to go head to head with 10kg+ yellowtails (Buri) or 7~8kg Kingfish.

SELFISH NS 614

The NS614 is a technical model designed for fishing in shallow waters between 20~40m in depth, targeting the selective adult kingfish. It is a highly sensitive model, with a flexible tip section while having a stiff belly section to feel for the action of the jig in the water. Anglers will be able to slide and control the jig by efficiently responding to the ever changing sea conditions, and control the thrashing of the monstrous kingfish with the grip-end under your armpits. It is also suitable to under-cast your lure to search a wider area and will respond quickly to those situations where the current is flowing towards you. This piece possesses numerous traits required for jigging in shallow waters.

The targets in the light jigging category are extremely diverse, and the lures, jigs, and methods required to target each of these species are also diverse, making it a complicated genre that varies depending on the area and season. New styles continue to emerge in various regions around the world, and the sport is expanding even further, going beyond the boundaries of an already fragmented game. The light jigging game we envision at Ripple Fisher is not simply the boat game using a lightweight jig with light line. It is however the operability of the rod to instantaneously decipher the situation unfolding before you, set your target with a clear vision, and select appropriate size jigs for your target. Whatever the situation, we have pursued for absolute sensitivity that allows anglers to feel for the presence of fish chasing your lure at the other end of the line, without limiting the anglers imagination and originality of choosing their lures. This can only be made possible by the finesse approach utilizing light line. The blank design further sharpens the rod's sensitivity and strength, which are necessary for catching targets lurking in the deep, bringing a more strategic approach to the world of vertical boat games. This rod was produced to unleash infinite possibilities of light jigging for anglers around the world. That is the new style we offer at Ripple Fisher and the background for the development of the Ocean Arrow Agile series.

AGILE 67ML

The 67ML is a model that excels at precision approaches using tungsten jigs or Tai-rubbers rigs in deep areas over 100-150m deep with fast flowing currents to target fish eaters that feed on micro baits. The highly sensitive and flexible tip to belly section accurately detects and transmits through the blank the subtle changes in the currents, allowing for precise jig control and a seamless hook-up. The 67ML is flexible yet powerful, successfully deflecting the powerful run of the fish while the stiff butt section provides control and ample lift to surface the fish. This is a technical model that is ideal for use with Tai-rubber rigs and tungsten jigs, but also allows anglers to utilize Inchiku and soft-plastics depending on the rapidly changing conditions of the sea.

AGILE 60MH

Designed with a regular taper, the 60MH features a highly-responsive blank with consistent stiffness from the tip to the butt section, allowing anglers to easily control various jig actions from high-pitch long jig actions to the slower and falling actions of shorter jigs. The sharp blank excels at delicate action and is compatible with a wide range of jig weights. Depending on how you use it, it offers great versatility and can flexibly adapt to any situation. While the blank is designed to induce the bites, the deep bend of the blank that maximizes the strength of light line will allow anglers to enjoy the thrilling battle against their monstrous targets. The 60MH is a rod that is specialized for light jigging in coastal waters targeting selective Blue runners, and can also be used as your spare tackle for more exotic expeditions. It is a light model that really shows its true qualities when utilizing a well-balanced light line setup.

This is a two piece grip jointed spinning model designed to jig for large Tuna. Similar to the 5930, it is designed so anglers can high-stick the rod and the longer rod length is set to avoid the line from scraping the hull of the boat resulting in a break-off. Although it is a PE6 class high powered jigging rod, the light feel of the rod will allow anglers to utilize various jerking patterns to induce that bite. The 6615 is a rod that will be useful in various locations around the world and for various species with power to control the thrashing fish, tenacity to continue to apply pressure on the fish and highly well balanced to maneuver the jigs. **Recommended size of tuna: More than 50 kg**

This is a one piece spinning model designed to jig for large size Tuna and Marlins around the world. The short length rod able to be high sticked will be advantageous for the angler at critical times when the fish is directly beneath the boat. The beautiful bending curve of the one piece blank allows anglers to maintain the high stick position which will continuously apply high pressure on the fish while reducing the load on the angler side. It is ideal for slow pitch jerk, one pitch jerk and other jerking patterns focusing on the sinking action of the heavy weight jigs. Anglers can also utilize the fighting belt to jerk or set the grip end under your armpits.

Recommended size of tuna: More than 50 kg

The Aquila series serves as the mid-class range in Ripple Fisher's offshore lineup, designed primarily for targeting Kingfish, Yellowfin Tuna, and Spanish Mackerel. The series is organized into four distinct categories, each built around a clear concept. Please select the model that best suits your specific scenario and fishing pattern.

Aquila Boat Casting

Spanish mackerel / Bonito / Kingfish / Yellowtail / Yellowfin Tuna

In our lineup of Aquila are 11 models. We have categorized them into four different series, ST, MLT, MST and EX. The ST series are the most standard models, which are well balanced and fine honed to cater for various situations and various targets. The MLT series have a combination of a flexible tip section and a stiff butt section to go after massive fish with light line. The MST series are the already popular models to go after monstrous Kingfish with sheer power and strength. The EX series are 3 piece pack rods for anglers traveling around the world. The Aquila series are rods built to defy the boundaries of fishing. It was our quest to seek lifting power, easy handling of lures, outstanding castability and last but not least, the ability to parry the angry fish. We don’ t simply make rods with “power” , we make rods with “strength” .

Aquila MST / MONSTER

The Aquila MST series have been designed for those anglers with their sights on monstrous Kingies. The main purpose of these rods are to enable anglers to go head to head with supersize fish with the use of strong PE7~8 class line and large lures for situations when the targets are feeding on large bait fish like, dorados, needle fish, flying fish etc. These rods are not just a stiff stick with power. On the contrary, in order to deal with sudden dives of the Kingfish, they have been designed with the bending point to transfer towards the angler as more load is applied to the blank. It is a user-friendly rod for any angler to use as you can load your weight on the rod by bending your knees during the fight.

※The + symbol next to the power class indicates that the power and tenacity has been added to the usual power class.

Aquila MST 85-7+

This is a model for anglers targeting supersize Kingfish with the use of 40g~ 120g lures. Although it is categorized as a power model, the lightness of the rod will allow anglers to cast all day long and freely pursue the lightning speed Kingfish. As the bending point transfers towards the angler once hooked up, anglers will be able to conduct a steady fight by countering your body weight against the fish by lowering your hips and loading the rod even when you’ re almost against the bow railing. Furthermore, the length of the rod will also assist you when conducting long casts towards feeding tuna.

Aquila MST 711-8+

This model is especially designed for anglers who face the dorado pattern, requiring them to utilize large lures up to 180g for the supersize Kingfish. It is also ideal for those anglers who like to go head to head with powerful fish in shallow areas. The underlying power of the rod also allows you to utilize this rod for the GT game. Compared to the ordinary GT rods, this rod will bend over more naturally, which is ideal for smaller/shorter and even female anglers.

Aquila MST 82-9+

In the ever evolving Kingfish game, the need to use large lures has increased with the target feeding on large size bait-fish. The MST82-9+ was designed to enable anglers to fully-cast lures exceeding 240mm while easily controlling and maneuvering these mammoth lures. Furthermore, the Aquila MST series are especially designed to tenaciously bend-in while demonstrating outstanding lifting power when fighting against monstrous Kings in rough terrain and gushing currents. Although we have designed the rod with easy utility, it is the strongest of the series and one will require ample body strength and experience to maximize its true potential. Having said that, we are confident that this rod will help anglers in the toughest of conditions, against the biggest of fish while using these large lures. We present this rod for those who are seeking monster-class Kings around the world.

Aquila MLT / MULTIPURPOSE

The Aquila MLT series were developed for situations where your targets are feeding on super small baitfish (white bait) and require anglers to utilize lighter tackle or for situations where the fish are highly sensitive towards fishing vessels and require anglers to cast long distances. You can say that we had to fuse together contradicting features of casting and controlling light lures while possessing the power for large species and maintaining the initiative of massive fish during the fight. It is a new generation of rods designed to catch large species with light tackle, requiring anglers to maximize the strength of the line. This line-up of rods compliments the compilation of models produced for our off-shore series.



Aquila MLT 82-2/4


The MLT82-2/4 has a tip section of a PE2 class, enabling anglers to accurately cast and control small ~ super small lures. It is an ideal model to overcome the challenging game where the white-bait are on the targets main menu. With its outstanding casting ability and controllability of the small lures, anglers will be able to reach great distances when casting and won’ t spook the fish from the presence of the boat. Although the tip section is light, the PE4 class butt section will enable anglers to maintain the initiative during the fight and lift the fish efficiently. Its versatility will allow anglers to target and land various species from the blue-runners, bonitos, dorados, and tuna. We hope this rod will assist those anglers who have been itching to cast smaller lures, farther, wider and with lighter line to catch your dream fish.

Aquila MLT 82-3/6

This is a model with increased power to PE6 class compared to the MLT82-2/4, but for use with small lures and light line. The tip section has the flexibility of a PE3 while the butt section possessing the power of a PE6. When comparing to the ordinary PE6 class rod, anglers will be able to swing through with less effort while increasing the accuracy and casting distance. The blank will bend over nicely once loaded yet possessing the underlying power to stop the monstrous fish. During the testing of this model, we were able to catch a 47kg yellowfin tuna in less than 10 minutes with a PE4 line. With the contradicting features of power (for lifting the fish) and flexibility (for casting and controlling smaller lures), you could say that this rod is at the pinnacle of Ripple Fishers’ rod making technology.

About Comfort Weight

In the Aquila series, the lure specs are listed as comfort weight. This is because the weight that can be cast will vary depending on the volume and specific gravity of the lure, how you cast it, and the line you use. Therefore, Aquila indicates the weight range that can be cast without stress. Since this is not the maximum value, slight fluctuations in the lower and upper limits are not a problem.

Aquila ST / STANDARD

The Aquila ST series are models which have had all the standard yet important factors for the casting game fused together at a high dimension. Specifically, the standard performances of casting, lure maneuverability, hooking up the fish and fighting. They have a sharp feeling and once the rods are loaded with the fish, the bending curve will gradually transfer towards the angler, allowing for a steady fight utilizing the butt power to maintain the initiative of the fight. We have prepared 4 power classes of PE #2, #3, #4 and #6 to cater for various species and situations.

Aquila ST 81-2

The model was designed to capture the selective species such as Spanish mackerel and bonitos around the bay. Focusing on the castability and operability of small lures, we dedicate this rod for those anglers who continuously cast until they hookup a fish. Once you are onto a fish, the reliable butt section will allow for a speedy fight and will help you catch great numbers especially when the feeding time is limited. It is a sharp blank typically seen in the ST series, and the belly section with ample stiffness helps easily control and maneuver the lure. This will allow anglers to utilize jerking action with minnows to induce bites from the spooked predators.

Aquila ST 78-3


The shorter rod length is designed for easy handling and casting for use on small – medium size boats. The tip section has sufficient stiffness, yet allows anglers to cast smaller size top water plugs to maneuver on the surface. It is an ideal rod for targeting bonitos, yellowtails and Kingfish, which require subtle lure control with light line. For those who own boats, you can target various species with this single versatile short length rod.

Aquila ST 80-4

This medium powered rod is your PE4 class casting rod for your local waters. Once loaded, the rod bends smoothly towards the butt section, creating a beautiful arc. Although it has a sharp feeling, the slow-tapered rod is designed to bend towards the butt section to absorb the thrashing run and enable a stable fight against 10kg class Kingfish.

Aquila ST 85-6

This ST85-6 have enough sharpness on blanks to deliver small lure like a bullet. Especially when you have to cast into boil of kingfish or tuna in head wind, you won't lose accuracy and you can deliver lure where you have wished to. It has been designed to be worked as like your arms on manipulating and provide you a stability on fighting.



Aquila EX / EXPEDITION


The Aquila EX series are the ultimate 3-piece expedition pack rod without compromises. Today, anglers are flying around the world to target their dream species and the farther you go, the more limitations there are regarding your luggage. Through countless trial and error, the Aquila EX series have now come to shape and ready to travel with you wherever you go. We have prepared a PE3 and PE6 class models for use with a vast range of lures with a super sharp feel to it. Although they are 3 piece models, it possesses a sharp feel to it and anglers will be able to bend and load the butt section of the rod to stop the monstrous targets. We are confident that these models will help you catch those rare species at the most remote areas around the world.

Aquila EX 79-3

The EX79-3 was designed with its sights on targets like the Cubera snapper, Roosterfish from Latin America and other exotic species that inhabit the various Amazon ponds in Asia. As you are limited with your tackle options when traveling the world, we have created this versatile rod for use with a vast range of lures from the large jig heads, poppers and diving pencils. The rod can be characterized as being a little stiffer compared to the ordinary grip joint rods, but it is a highly responsive rod also ideal for use in the casting game targeting the bonitos and yellowtails from smaller boats.

Aquila EX 83-6

The EX83-6 is a most ideal as a light tackle rod for the GT game or Kingfish game. Through the countless testing phases, we were able to come up with a "flexible" tip section which is extremely rare for pack-rods, enabling anglers to easily control the subtle action of middle size diving pencils. During the field-testing, the butt section was able to stop the run of the GT in shallow waters of 6m, while the rest of the rod was bending and absorbing the power of the angry GT. The rod has proven itself that it can be one of your trusted main weapons for your exotic expeditions around the world.



*Static load comparison does not represent all rod characteristics such as repulsion force. There are individual differences in how the load is applied when actually bending the rod, so please use this as a guide only.

We have upgraded and optimized these models to cater for the ever-changing needs and environment around us.

We did not simply make it more bendy nor make it cast farther than before. Rather, through the combination of various different materials of carbon sheets and unique taper design with underlying butt power, we were able to realize a rod capable of enduring extreme load while the recovery force lifting the fish from the deep.

We hope you feel our dedicated passion through the blanks of BIG TUNA series.

We have set the power category as follows in order for a more comprehensive understanding. The 86, 710RT, 73, 76, 70 are all in the same line max category however the 73, 76, 70 have been designed with a higher breakage point suited for targeting 200kg class fish which are in a different power category from 86 and 710RT. The 86 and 710RT models can be used in situations where a long cast is required or more sensitive action is required.

*Please note that aiming huge tuna over 100kg in rough conditions is dangerous. Regarding "models that are designed for extremely large bluefin tuna" such as BIG TUNA 73, 76, and 70, the explanations and specifications are written assuming that you have the appropriate physical strength, training, and experience. Thank you for your understanding.

The 85F, 87AS, and 83 models are also useful for targeting yellowfin tuna, and the standard is 85F for tuna size 50kg or less, and 87AS and 83 for tuna size 80kg or less. Please consider the lure size to be used, the line, the size of the tuna, and the lure appeal required, and choose a model. *Even though the maximum line value is the same, the set drag value will vary depending on the model, so please keep this in mind when choosing a rod.

*If you are looking for a lighter model than the BIG TUNA series, we also recommend the Aquila series' MLT82-3/6, MST85-7+ and MLT82-3/6 does not have as strong a butt power as the BIG TUNA series, but it has an achievement of catching tuna over 50kg during testing. This model is also recommended for those who want to cast small lures when using ultra-small bait patterns such as whitebait. MST85-7+ has a short length grip, allowing for faster and more agile casting. It has excellent long-distance casting performance, so it is recommended for both shooting to fish feeding on surface and luring out.



The rod design of the BIG TUNA series is color-coded with thread colors matching the power class on the left. Also, the model name is engraved on the spacer on the reel sheet of the grip.

4 POWER CLASS

BIG TUNA 85F JAPAN Special Light Class

This is a model capable of being high stucked while also being able to cast small lures a great distance. Anglers will be able to utilize lures ranging from 18g~120g and line ranging from PE3~6. We have given this rod a wide range to deal with the high pressure from anglers as well as to induce bites when the Tuna are feeding on small baits. Although it is classed as a light rod in the lineup, you will be able to land 50kg Yellowfin and Bluefin Tuna.

BIG TUNA 87AS JAPAN Special Middle Class

As its name suggests, the AS (Accuracy Shoot) model is designed to accurately cast lures into the feeding fish. In addition to the steady blank kick-back after casting, we have equipped two RV guides on the butt enabling an extremely smooth line ejection from the reel through to the rod. The casting ability will support anglers when the feeding frenzy is far or in heavy conditions casting into the wind. It is not only able to cast large lures but the blank will also allow the use of small 40g size lures. This middle class rod will assist anglers with its taper design ideal to slowly but surely lift the fish from the deep while being able to high-stick the rod.

※If you prefer a more speedy fight (same size fish) we recommend the 83. (87AS is 1 rank lighter compared to the 83. Furthermore, the 87AS is a totally different model and design to the 87 which has been discontinued.)

BIG TUNA 83 JAPAN Special Middle Class

This model was developed with "lure control" and "fight" as its main focus, but it goes without saying that casting is also outstanding. It is a PE6~8 middle class rod not only able to pinpoint cast but also able to utilize small mouthed diving poppers and diving pencils required for an attack. You will be able to realize the evolution of our BIG TUNA series with its lightness and outstanding balance, allowing anglers to cast all day long. Furthermore, the bending point is set close to the body enabling anglers to easily bend in and capitalize on the butt power with little effort.

BIG TUNA 86 JAPAN Special Heavy Class

If you require long and accurate casting with a heavy class tackle, this 86 will be your choice. In comparison to your ordinary heavy tackle, the flexible tip on the 86 will allow for easier casting of smaller lures when the bait-fish are small though the Tuna are huge. The bending point (pivotal point) is closer to the body allowing anglers to take initiative during the fight.

BIG TUNA 710RT JAPAN Special Heavy Class

Compared to the characteristics of the original model, we have re-designed the model to suit the current tuna scene. Since we have designed the taper of the blank to be most productive in the butt section, anglers will be able to efficiently and effectively utilize the butt power to lift the tuna. It's not simply a more flexible model compared to its predecessor, but a highly well-balanced heavy class model able to effortlessly stimulate bites from casting top water lures while having the power to go head to head with the biggest of fish. This will be your ideal model if you are in situations where you need to cast lures all day long.

BIG TUNA 76 JAPAN Special Power Class


This model is for anglers with their sights on Blue-fin tuna weighing over 200kg. Similar to the 73, this 76 is capable of not only casting large lures mostly used when the targets are feeding on dolphin fish (mahi-mahi), but also allows anglers to cast and control the lighter (60g) sinking pencils for smaller baits. The difference from the 73 will be the contrasting fight style. While possessing strong butt power to constantly apply pressure on the fish, we have drastically reduced the load on the angler by bringing the bending point closer to the angler, allowing for a prolonged fight.

BIG TUNA 73 JAPAN Special Power Class

This model is for anglers with their sights on Blue fin tuna weighing over 200kg. Its castability is next to non, able to accurately hit feeding targets with large lures most productive when they are feeding on dolphin fish (mahi mahi). Being short in length and the stiffest model in the series, it is most suited for anglers who have confidence in their strength and ability to go head to head with the monstrous tuna.

BIG TUNA 70 JAPAN Special Power Class


This is for those anglers with their sights on super monstrous Blue-fin tuna. It is model for anglers who need to "high-stick the rod" to land the blank or utilize the "straight pumping" fight style. The power of the rod is similar to the BT76 and BT73 but the breaking point is much greater compared to these two. With the shorter designed blank, the bending point is set closer to the body, drastically reducing the load and stress on the angler. It also has enough length and leverage to go around the bow or other obstacles on the boat for a smoother fight.




BIG TUNA Bending Curve



The 85F and 87AS are more flexible able to cast small lures and designed for a more mellow fight with the fish, whereas the 83 and 86 are a more aggressive rod with the bending point towards the tip to efficiently lift and fight the fish. Compared with the same middle-class rods of 87AS, the 83 is a one rank stronger rod.



The illustration shows the comparison of the 2 heavy class rods. Both rods have a similar taper design but the difference lies in the length. By utilizing the length of the 86 blank, anglers will be able to cast farther than other shorter rods while the shorter 710RT is a model able to load the blank with the weight of the fish with ease.



The picture illustrates the comparison of the 3 power class models. When looking at the comparison with a 45 degree angle, the 73 and 76 look similar, however, the bending point of the 76 is closer to the angler, reducing the stress on the angler, while the 73 is further away enabling a more speedy fight against the fish. The 70 has the strongest butt power with the bending point being close to the angler, drastically reducing the load on the angler. The three models are the same power class, yet having totally different characteristics.
